he existing I-95 southbound exit ramp to Atlantic Boulevard will undergo a full, around the clock closure for approximately six months, beginning 11:30 p.m. Sunday night, March 12 for ramp reconstruction activities. Traffic will be detoured to a new temporary ramp just south of the existing ramp. FHP will on site to assist motorists.

This \$154 million, 8-mile project began construction on October, 2016 and is expected to be completed in spring 2020, weather permitting. Work is being performed by Prince Contracting, Inc., with HNTB Corporation administering the construction contract for the Florida Department of Transportation.

Maintenance of Traffic

The new temporary ramp will open to traffic at 5 a.m., Monday morning, March 13, 2017. The temporary ramp will feature three westbound turn lanes and two eastbound turn lanes onto Atlantic Boulevard.
