

### SE 6TH AVENUE, THE RIO VISTA BOULEVARD LOOP, AND EAST AVENUE TO CLOSE THURSDAY NIGHT, MAY 2

As part of the Henry E. Kinney Tunnel Improvements and Pedestrian Plaza project, SE 6th Avenue, the Rio Vista Boulevard loop, and East Avenue will be closed from 10 p.m. until 6 a.m. on Thursday night, May 2 for milling and resurfacing operations. To ensure motorist and crew safety, traffic will be detoured via SE 6th Street and SE 9th Avenue to SE 5th Court or N Rio Vista Boulevard. Monday, May 6 will be used as contingency if needed. On-street parking on SE 6th Avenue, N Rio Vista Boulevard, and East Avenue will not be available. Parking lot access on SE 6th Avenue will be maintained periodically throughout the night.



This project will rehabilitate the structural, mechanical, electrical, architectural, and safety components of the Henry E. Kinney Tunnel; mill and resurface SR-5/US-1 from Rio Vista Boulevard to south of the Tunnel; install Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) along SR-5/US-1; extend the tunnel top to accommodate a pedestrian plaza which will include new fountains, seating facilities, re-designed brick pavers, artificial turf and landscape installation, and reconstruct the intersection of Las Olas Boulevard at SE 6th Avenue.
