The I-95 southbound entrance ramps from Oakland Park Boulevard will undergo a full closure, nightly, as needed, 11:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday night, through May, for construction activities. Traffic will be detoured via Powerline Road and Sunrise Boulevard. FHP will on site to assist motorists.

This \$149 million, 6.7-mile project began construction on August 21, 2016 and is expected to be completed in spring 2020, weather permitting. Work is being performed by The DeMoya Group, Inc., with New Millennium Engineering, Inc. administering the construction contract for the Florida Department of Transportation.
