



**CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE
BROWARD MOBILITY PROJECT**



Project Overview

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has awarded a \$15 million contract to Construct Group Corp. for the construction of sidewalks, multi-use pedestrian paths, and bicycle lanes along 45 roadways in Broward County. Construction began February 2, 2015 and will be completed in Fall 2018. This project is part of a larger \$100 million investment from the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) to provide bicycle, pedestrian, and public transportation access throughout the Broward region. Project Improvements

Construction along SW 31 Avenue in Fort Lauderdale is expected to begin May 22, 2017 and be completed in summer 2017.

SW 31 Avenue from Riverland Road to SW 14 Street

- Adding 4-5 foot wide bike lanes in each direction by widening the existing roadway
- Removing old asphalt and resurfacing the corridor
- Reconstructing curb-side bus stops at various locations

SW 31 Avenue from SW 14 Street to Broward Boulevard

- Adding 4-5 foot wide bike lanes in each direction by reducing lane widths from SW 12 Place to Broward Boulevard
- Adding sharrow pavement markings from SW 13 Street to SW 12 Place
- Removing old asphalt and resurfacing from SW 14 Street to SW 12 Place and from SW 2 Court to Broward Boulevard
- Reconstructing curb-side bus stops at various locations
- Constructing a concrete sidewalk along the east side of the corridor at SW 14 Street

Traffic Impact

Single lane closures can be expected Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. and Sunday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m.
