



I-95 LIGHTING IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT IN HALLANDALE BEACH, HOLLYWOOD, AND PEMBROKE PARK

Project Overview

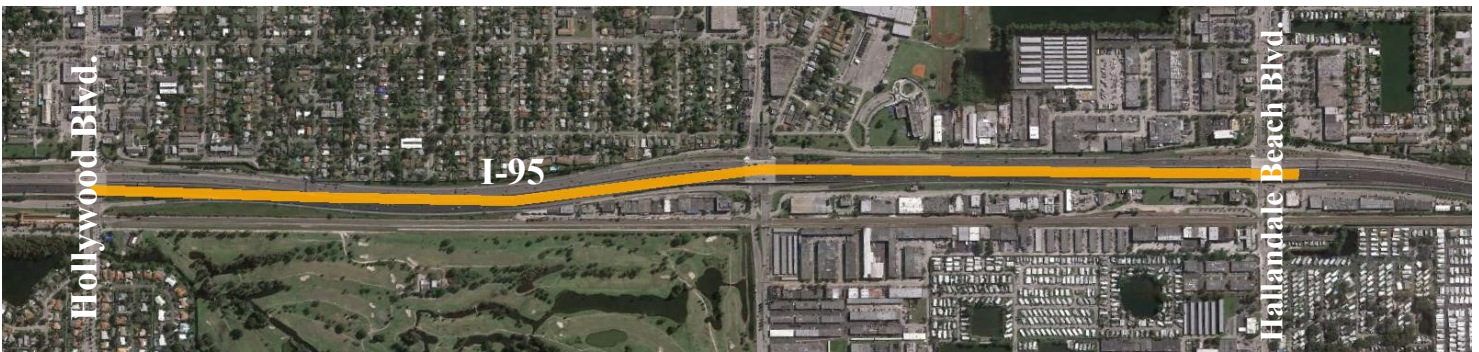
The Florida Department of Transportation has awarded a \$1.9 million contract to Florida Safety Contractors, Inc., to add new lighting along Interstate 95, from Hallandale Beach Boulevard to Hollywood Boulevard. The length of the project is 2.5 miles. Construction began February 13, 2017 and is expected to be completed by late 2017.

Project Improvements

- Installation of new light poles, conduit, and conductors within project limits
- Installation of barrier wall and guardrail
- Installation of new load centers for electrical components

Traffic Impact

- One lane in each direction of I-95 between Hallandale Beach Boulevard and Hollywood Boulevard may be closed Sunday through Thursday between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.
