



OLD DIXIE HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT IN FORT LAUDERDALE

Project Overview

The Florida Department of Transportation awarded a \$2,571,390.2 contract to Ferreira Construction Southern Division Co., Inc., for roadway improvements along Old Dixie Highway from north of NE 13th Street to south of the bridge over the Middle River in Fort Lauderdale. The length of the project is approximately 0.9 miles. Construction will begin March 6, 2017 and is expected to be completed by Early 2018.

Project Improvements

- Reducing the width of the travel lanes and modifying shoulders to add 4-foot bike lanes in both directions throughout the project limits
- Constructing sidewalk throughout project limits
- Drainage improvements
- Adding roundabout at NE 16th Court
- Permanently reducing 35 MPH speed limit to 25 MPH throughout project limits
- Installation of pedestrian lighting
- Adding landscaping and swales to improve drainage throughout project limits
- Removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway within project limits
- Constructing 8 raised intersections and 6 raised pedestrian crosswalks
- Adding new signing and pavement markings

Traffic Impact

- Lane closures can be expected along Old Dixie Highway from NE 13th Street to the bridge over the Middle River Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.
