



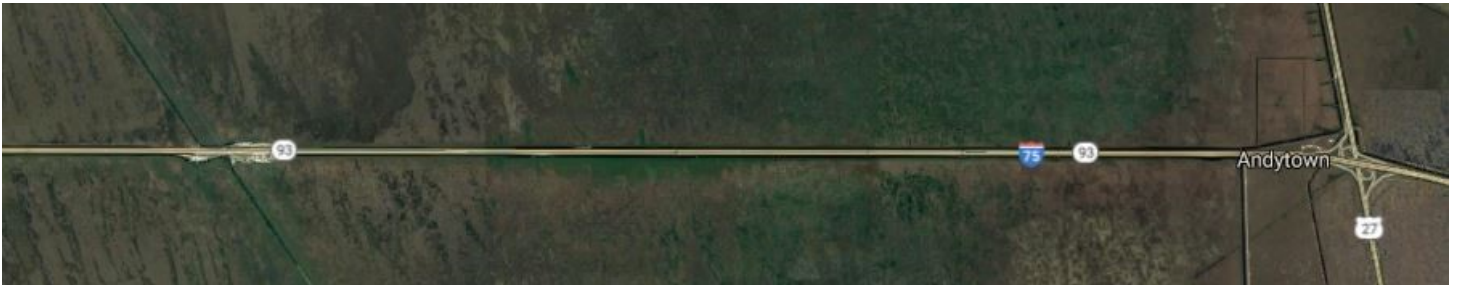
SR 93 / I-75 ALLIGATOR ALLEY RECREATION AND REST AREA IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Project Overview

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has awarded a \$ 316,709.38 contract to Tadeos Engineering LLC for recreation and rest area improvements along State Road 93 / I-75 Alligator Alley from Mile Marker 32 to Mile Marker 41. Construction will begin May 30, 2017 and will be completed late 2017.

Project Improvements

- Installing an informational kiosk pavilion in the recreational areas at each of the following locations:
 - ◊ Pavilion 1: Mile Marker 41
 - ◊ Pavilion 2: Mile Marker 38
 - ◊ Pavilion 3: Mile Marker 36
 - ◊ Pavilion 4: Mile Marker 35
 - ◊ Pavilion 5: Mile Marker 35
 - ◊ Pavilion 6: Mile Marker 32
 - ◊ Pavilion 7: Mile Marker 32
- These new 14-foot by 26-foot pavilions will have red roofs and be used to display educational information.



Traffic Impact

- No lane closures are expected on I-75.
- Parking spaces within the rest areas may be utilized outside of the work zone.
