**SR 7 from Broward / Palm Beach County  
Line to south of Glades Road  
in Palm Beach County**

**Timeline**

September 10, 2017 — Spring 2020

**Contractor**

Community Asphalt Co.

**Cost**

\$14,264,238

**Improvements**

- Removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway
- Upgrading pedestrian features including 10-foot sidewalks on both sides and detectable warning surfaces at crosswalks
- Installing overhead sign structures
- Upgrading signs and pavement markings to include a 7-foot bike lane in each direction
- Installing new bus shelters with bicycle racks, trash receptacles, and benches
- Upgrading drainage structures
- Upgrading signalization, including pedestrian signals and detectors and vehicle video detection
- Upgrading lighting

**Traffic Impact**

- One lane in each direction may be closed nightly between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- Two lanes in each direction may be closed nightly between 11 p.m. and 6 a.m.

August 4, 2017 — Spring 2019  
\*Project Completed March 1, 2019

**Contractor**

General Asphalt Corp.

**Cost**

\$6,772,377.23

**Improvements**

- Removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway
- Minor shoulder widening
- Upgrading drainage structures
- Upgrading pedestrian features including a 10-foot sidewalk on the west side, a 5-foot sidewalk on the east side, and detectable warning surfaces at crosswalks
- Upgrading signalization, including pedestrian signals and detectors and vehicle video detection
- Upgrading signs and pavement markings to include a 7-foot bike lane in each direction
- Upgrading lighting

**Traffic Impact**

- One lane in each direction may be closed nightly between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- Two lanes in each direction may be closed nightly between 11 p.m. and 6 a.m.
