SR 7/US 441 OVER SR 834/SAMPLE ROAD BRIDGE MAINTENANCE PROJECT

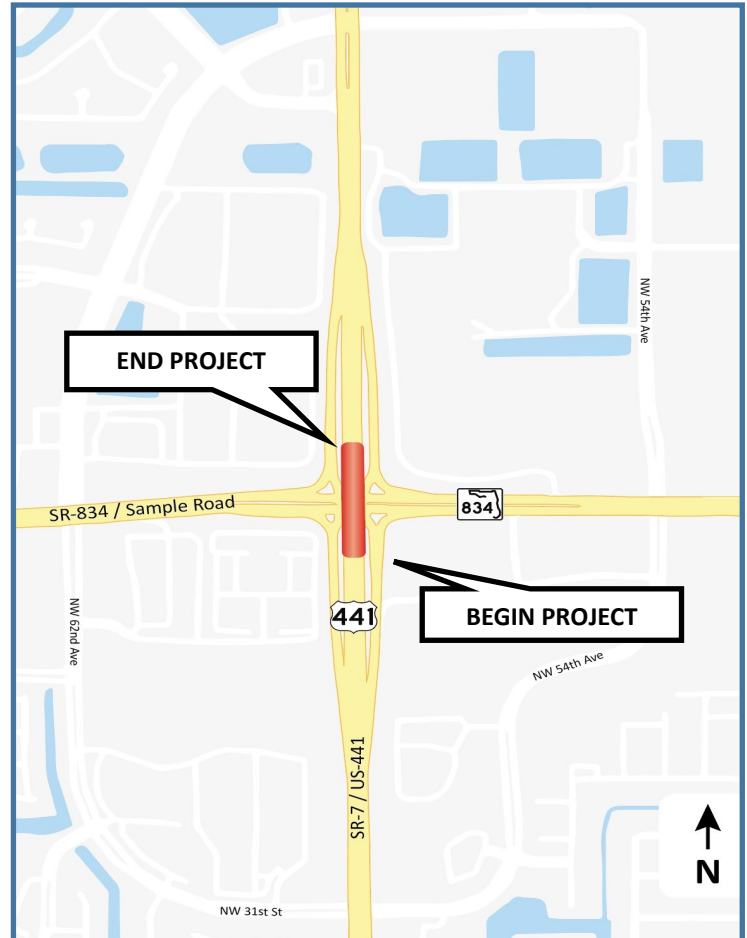
The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, is pleased to provide information regarding routine maintenance and repair of the SR 7/US 441 bridges over SR 834/Sample Road in the cities of Coconut Creek, Coral Springs and Margate.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Paint the steel and concrete portions of the SR 7/US 441 northbound and southbound bridges (Bridge Nos. 860593 and 860644) over SR 834/Sample Road

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Periodic single lane closures may occur on SR 7/US 441 at Sample Road.
- Full closures of eastbound Sample Road at State Road 7 may occur from 8:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. Sunday through Thursday.
- Full closures of westbound Sample Road at State Road 7 may occur from 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Sunday through Thursday.
- Detours will be provided during full closures to direct motorists. Eastbound and westbound Sample Road will not be closed simultaneously.
- Pedestrian detours will be in place during sidewalk closures.
- Access to residences and businesses will be maintained at all times.
