



### **Project Overview**

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has awarded a \$15 million contract to Construct Group Corp. for the construction of sidewalks, multi-use pedestrian paths, and bicycle lanes along 45 roadways in Broward County. Construction began February 2, 2015 and will be completed in Fall 2018. This project is part of a larger \$100 million investment from the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) to provide bicycle, pedestrian, and public transportation access throughout the Broward region. ### **Project Improvements**

Construction in Lauderhill is expected to begin July 10, 2017 and be completed in fall 2017.

#### **NW 36 Ave. from Broward Blvd. to NW 1 Ct.**

- Constructing a 5-foot concrete sidewalk along the west side of the corridor, filling in the missing gaps

#### **NW 35 Ave. from Broward Blvd. to NW 1 Ct.**

- Constructing a 5-foot concrete sidewalk along the west side of the corridor, filling in the missing gaps

#### **NW 34 Ave. from Broward Blvd. to NW 1 Ct.**

- Constructing a 5-foot concrete sidewalk along the west side of the corridor, filling in the missing gaps
- Removing the existing paver sidewalk along the east side of the corridor and replacing it with a 5-foot concrete sidewalk

#### **NW 32 Ave. from Broward Blvd. to Dead End**

- Constructing a 5-foot concrete sidewalk along both sides of the corridor, filling in the missing gaps

### **Traffic Impact**

Single lane closures can be expected Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. and Sunday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m.
