



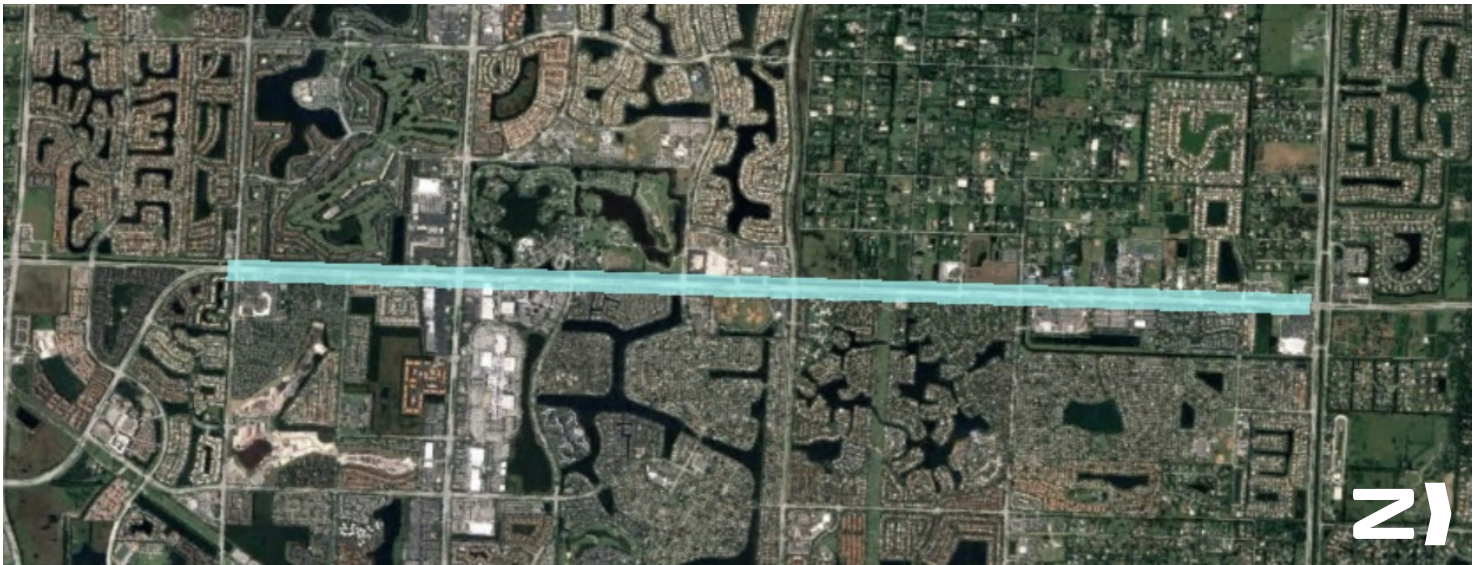
FLAMINGO ROAD IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT IN MIRAMAR, PEMBROKE PINES, COOPER CITY, AND SOUTHWEST RANCHES

Project Overview

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has awarded a \$2,267,493.75 contract to General Asphalt Company, Inc. for improvements along Flamingo Road from 700 feet south of Pembroke Road to Griffin Road in Miramar, Pembroke Pines, Cooper City, and Southwest Ranches. Construction will begin May 20, 2017 and will be completed in early 2018.

Project Improvements

- Replacing guardrail along the west side of the road
- Installing a mat to protect canal from erosion
- Replacing sidewalk at various locations as needed to accommodate new guardrail
- Improving drainage by adding concrete aprons around existing drainage structures
- Replacing some existing signs



Traffic Impact

- Construction activities and lane closures can be expected on southbound Flamingo Road as follows:
 - Single lane closures— between 9:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.
 - Double lane closures—between 10 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. and overnight between 10:30 p.m. and 7:30 a.m.
- Specific lane closure information will be provided in the weekly traffic report distributed by FDOT.
