HURRICANE IRMA REPAIR IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Four, has awarded a contract to Arc Electric Inc., for repairs along SR 93/I-75 and SR 852/I-595 in the cites of Weston, Dania Beach, Fort Lauderdale and the Miccosukee Tribe of Florida.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Replacing a high mast light pole along westbound SR 93/I-75 at Exit 49 to Snake Road.
- Replacing the overhead sign structures at southbound SR 93/ I-75 at Exit 19 and eastbound SR 852/ I-595 at Exit 12B to northbound US-1.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Shoulder closures are anticipated along SR 93/I-75 at Exit 49 to Snake Road.
- Lane closures will occur along southbound SR 93/I-75 at Exit 19 overnight, Sunday through Thursday between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- Lane closures will occur along eastbound SR 852/ I-595 at Exit 12B overnight, Sunday through Thursday between 12 a.m. and 4 a.m.
