## SR 7/US 441 PEDESTRIAN SAFETY ENHANCEMENT PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will implement safety enhancements on SR 7/US 441 from NW 36<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 41<sup>st</sup> Street in Broward County. This project in the City of Lauderdale Lakes will address pedestrian safety by constructing a signalized mid-block pedestrian crossing. The mid-block crossing will serve as a connector to the Middle River Trail on the west and east side of SR 7/US 441 between NW 37<sup>th</sup> Street and NW 41<sup>st</sup> Street.

#### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Installation of signalization and pavement markings for new mid-block pedestrian crossing. The mid-block crossing will serve as a connector to the Middle Rive Trail on the west and east side of SR 7/US 441 between NW 37<sup>th</sup> Street and NW 41<sup>st</sup> Street.
- Installation of 18 decorative pedestrian lights primarily on the east side to increase visibility between NW 36<sup>th</sup> Street and NW 41<sup>st</sup> Street along SR 7/US 441.

## TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Work zone travel speed: 40 mph
- Lane closures will occur:
  9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Monday—Friday
  9:00 p.m. to 7:30 a.m. as needed
- Access to residents and businesses will be maintained at all times.
