#### SAFETY PROJECT FOR SR 858/HALLANDALE BEACH BOULEVARD

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will conduct a Construction Open House regarding the safety improvements project along SR 858/Hallandale Beach Boulevard east of the SFRC crossing to west of Ansin Boulevard. Representatives from the FDOT and project partners will be available to answer your questions. This meeting will have an informal open house format; no formal presentation will be made. Construction plans will be available for public viewing.

**Construction Cost: \$2,257,890**

**Construction Start Date: July 29, 2019**

**Anticipated Completion: Spring 2020**

#### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the existing pavement along Hallandale Beach Boulevard from the SFRC crossing to west of Ansin Boulevard.
- Widening and resurfacing the I-95 northbound off-ramp to Hallandale Beach Boulevard, to provide an additional right-turn lane.
- Widening and resurfacing the I-95 southbound off-ramp to Hallandale Beach Boulevard, to extend vehicle storage capacity of the right-turn lane.
- Upgrading the existing traffic signals at the intersections of Hallandale Beach Boulevard and the I-95 off-ramps.
- Reconstructing the sidewalks and pedestrian crossings on the I-95 northbound off-ramp to Hallandale Beach Boulevard.
- Upgrading the existing lighting along the I-95 off-ramps to Hallandale Beach Boulevard and underneath the I-95 bridge to LED lighting.

#### TRAFFIC IMPACTS DURING CONSTRUCTION

- The I-95 northbound and southbound off-ramps to Hallandale Beach Boulevard will be reduced to one right-turn and left-turn lane.
- Full ramp closures on the I-95 off-ramps to Hallandale Beach Boulevard can be expected overnight, Sunday through Thursday, between 9:00 p.m. and 5:30 a.m., for paving operations.
- Single lane closures in each direction of Hallandale Beach Boulevard can be expected, Monday through Thursday, between 9:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., and between 9:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.
- Additional lane closure and detour information will be provided in the weekly traffic report distributed by FDOT.

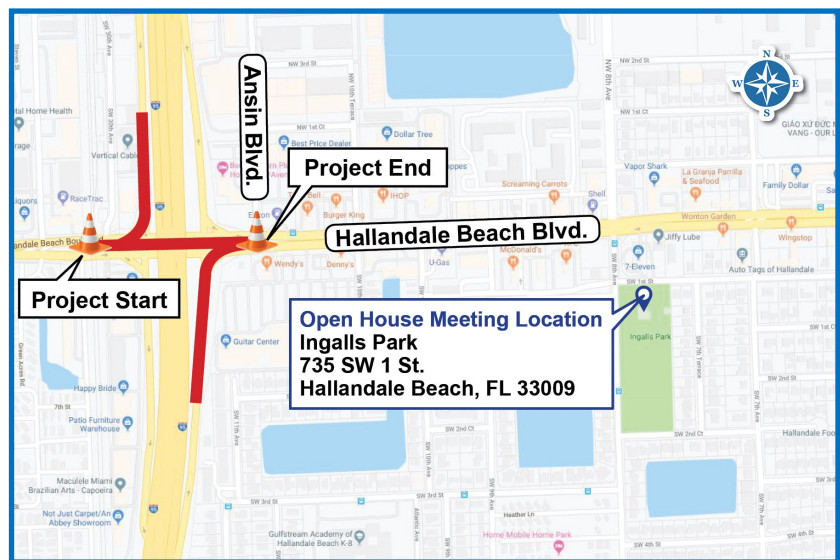
