I-75 LANDSCAPING IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Four, has awarded a contract to Visualscape, Inc. for improvements to landscaping at the I-75 and Sheridan Street Interchange and in each corner of the Stirling Road Bridge over I-75.

Construction Cost: \$1.6 million

Construction Start Date: July 15, 2019

Anticipated Completion: Spring 2020

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Installing several species of palms and shade trees at the I-75 and Sheridan Street Interchange and in each quadrant at the Stirling Road Bridge over I-75.
- Installing a temporary irrigation system at the I-75 and Sheridan Street Interchange for the warranty period of the newly installed landscape.

TRAFFIC IMPACT

- Shoulder closures will be used to deliver equipment and materials along I-75, and the I-75 and Sheridan Street Interchange.
- Additional information about lane closures will be provided in the weekly traffic report distributed by FDOT.

MAINTENANCE

- Performing periodic (monthly) litter removal and mowing operations within the project limits.
- Upon completion of the project, the contractor will maintain the temporary irrigation and installed landscaping for a two-year warranty period.
