The I-95 northbound entrance ramps from Sunrise Boulevard will undergo a full closure, nightly, 11:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday night, July 9 through Thursday night, July 13, for construction activities. Traffic will be detoured via Oakland Park Boulevard and Powerline Road. FHP will on site to assist motorists.

This \$149 million, 6.7-mile project began construction on August 21, 2016 and is expected to be completed in spring 2020, weather permitting. Work is being performed by The de Moya Group, Inc., with New Millennium Engineering, Inc. administering the construction contract for the Florida Department of Transportation.
