## SR 7/US 441 PEDESTRIAN SAFETY ENHANCEMENT PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will be implementing pedestrian safety enhancements along SR 7/US 441 from NW 29th Street to 520-feet north of SR 816/Oakland Park Boulevard.

### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Construct a pedestrian safety barrier along existing median
- Construct a 10-foot shared-use path along the east side of SR 7/US 441
- Minor roadway widening and resurfacing.
- Upgrade crosswalk markings at NW 29th Street and Oakland Park Boulevard
- Install landscaping and irrigation improvements in the median
- Install crosswalk curb ramps

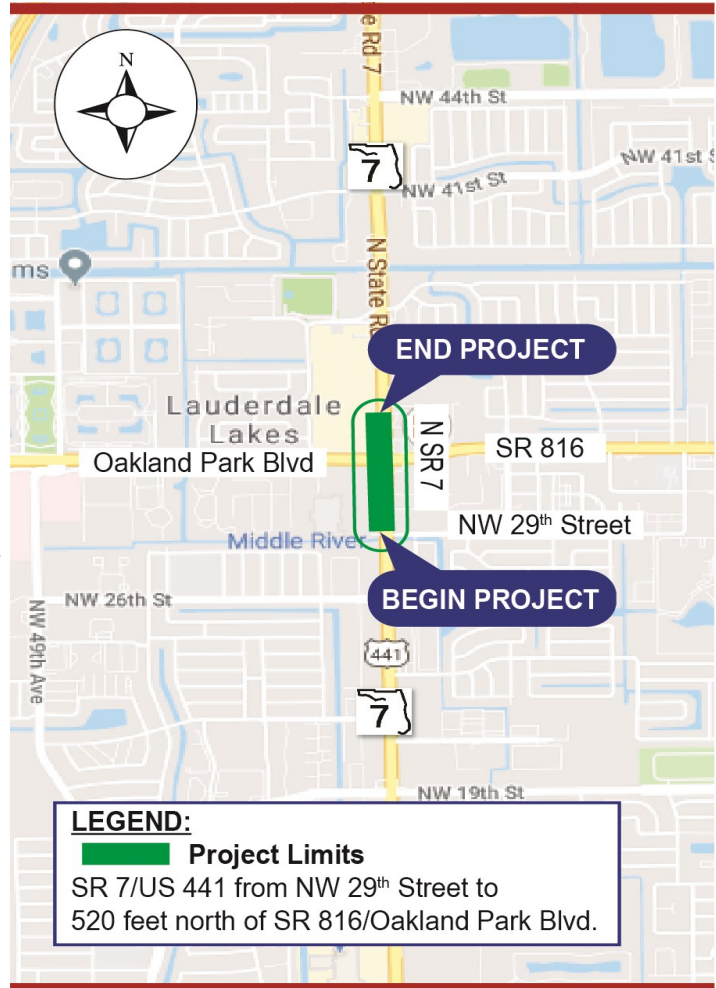
### TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Work zone travel speed: 40 mph
- Two northbound and southbound travel lanes may be closed during non-peak hours
- Non-peak hours are:
  - \*9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. weekdays and weekends
  - \*9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Sunday — Thursday nights
  - \*11 p.m. to 7 a.m. Friday and Saturday nights
- Sidewalk closures, pedestrian detours as needed
