



NE 6TH AVENUE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT IN OAKLAND PARK



Project Overview

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has awarded a \$312,963.47 contract to Weekley Asphalt Paving Co. for improvements along NE 6th Avenue from Oakland Park Boulevard to Commercial Boulevard in Oakland Park. Construction will begin August 4, 2017 and will be completed in late 2017.

This project is part of a larger \$100 million investment from the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) to provide bicycle, pedestrian, and public transportation access throughout the Broward region. The goal of this initiative is to complete Broward's bicycle and pedestrian network and provide safe facilities for our residents and visitors who walk and cycle. Project Improvements

- Constructing new sidewalk along the east side of the road
- Relocating drainage structures
- Minor widening toward the shoulders
- Adding curb and gutter along the east side of the road
- Upgrading crosswalks to meet ADA standards
- Upgrading lighting at Oakland Park Boulevard and Commercial Boulevard
- Adding sharrows to indicate that the travel lanes are to be shared with bicyclists

Traffic Impact

Construction work activities and lane closures can be expected as follows:

- One lane in each direction of NE 6th Avenue from Oakland Park Boulevard to Commercial Boulevard may be closed weekdays between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. and between 6 p.m. and 7 a.m.

Specific lane closure information will be provided in the weekly traffic report distributed by FDOT.
