



SW 4 AVENUE AT SW 28 STREET INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT IN FORT LAUDERDALE

Project Overview

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has awarded a \$741,586.31 contract to Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc. for improvements at the intersection of SW 4 Avenue and SW 28 Street in Fort Lauderdale. Construction will begin August 20, 2017 and will be completed in spring 2018.

Project Improvements

- Installing new mast arm signals to replace the existing four-way stop signs
- Upgrading sidewalk and pedestrian curb ramps
- Removing old asphalt and resurfacing the intersection
- Minor widening along SW 28 Street to add left turn lanes
- Upgrading pavement markings and signs
- Installing new drainage structures

Traffic Impact

- Construction work activities and lane closures can be expected as follows:
 - Weekdays and Weekends — 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.
 - Sunday through Thursday evenings — 8 p.m. to 6 a.m.
 - Friday and Saturday evenings — 11 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- Specific lane closure information will be provided in the weekly traffic report distributed by FDOT.
