



PEMBROKE ROAD AT OLEANDER DRIVE INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT IN MIRAMAR

Project Overview

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has awarded a \$621,301.81 contract to Weekley Asphalt Paving Inc. for improvements at the intersection of Pembroke Road at Oleander Drive in Miramar. Construction will begin September 1, 2017 and will be completed in early Spring 2018.

Project Improvements

- Removing existing asphalt and resurfacing the intersection
- Installing a new signalized intersection with mast arms
- Adding crosswalks on both sides of the intersection to provide access across Pembroke Road
- Installing eight countdown pedestrian signals
- Replacing drainage structures on Oleander Drive just south of Pembroke Road
- Installing approximately 112 feet of sidewalk on the west side of Oleander Drive just south of Pembroke Road



Traffic Impact

- One lane in each direction of Pembroke Road at Oleander Drive may be closed during non-peak hours. Peak hours are Monday through Friday from 6:00 a.m. through 9:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. through 6:30 p.m.
- A full closure of Oleander Drive from Pembroke Road to Venetian Street is expected for drainage structure installations. More information about this closure and the detour that will be in place will be included in FDOT's weekly traffic report.
