NW 19 STREET BIKE LANES AND REHABILITATION PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has awarded a contract to Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc. for improvements to NW 19 Street from State Road (SR) 7 to Powerline Road in Lauderdale Lakes, Lauderhill, and Fort Lauderdale..

The Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is investing over \$300 million to create safer, healthier communities in Broward. This project is one of many within a larger plan to create enhanced bicycle, pedestrian, and public transportation access throughout the Broward region. The Broward MPO is a federally-mandated agency that is responsible for making decisions on local transportation issues and deciding how to spend federal funds on transportation projects within Broward. PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Widening, resurfacing and restriping the roadway to accommodate the following configuration from SR 7 to NW 31 Avenue: 4-foot designated bike lanes and two 10-foot through lanes in each direction separated by a continuous two-way left turn lane in the center of the roadway
- Upgrading pedestrian signals and modifying pedestrian curb ramps and sidewalks to meet ADA requirements from SR 7 to NW 31 Avenue
- Relocating existing drainage system to accommodate widening areas from SR 7 to NW 31 Avenue
- Upgrading lighting at SR 7 and Powerline Road intersections

TRAFFIC IMPACT

- Access to properties will be maintained at all times.
- Lane closures can be expected daily between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. and overnight between 11 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- At least one lane in each direction of NW 19 Street will be maintained at all times.
- Additional information about lane closures will be provided in the weekly traffic report distributed by FDOT.
