The I-95 northbound entrance ramps from Broward Boulevard will undergo a full closure, around the clock, beginning 11 p.m., Friday, Sept. 16 through 5 a.m., Monday morning, Sept. 18, for construction activities. Eastbound and westbound Broward Boulevard to I-95 northbound traffic will be detoured via the Broward Boulevard Park & Ride facility and I-95 northbound. FHP will be on scene to assist motorists.

This \$149 million, 6.7-mile project began construction on August 21, 2016 and is expected to be completed in spring 2020, weather permitting. Work is being performed by The de Moya Group, Inc., with New Millennium Engineering, Inc. administering the construction contract for the Florida Department of Transportation.
