Project Length: Approximately 0.90 miles (exception at drawbridge)

Proposed Improvements:

- Repaving the existing roadway
- Upgrading non-compliant sidewalk ramps
- Adding a new signalized intersection on SR 844 at NE 28th Avenue
- Upgrading pedestrian signal features and pedestrian lighting at signalized intersections:
 - US 1
 - NE 23rd Avenue
 - NE 28th Avenue (New)

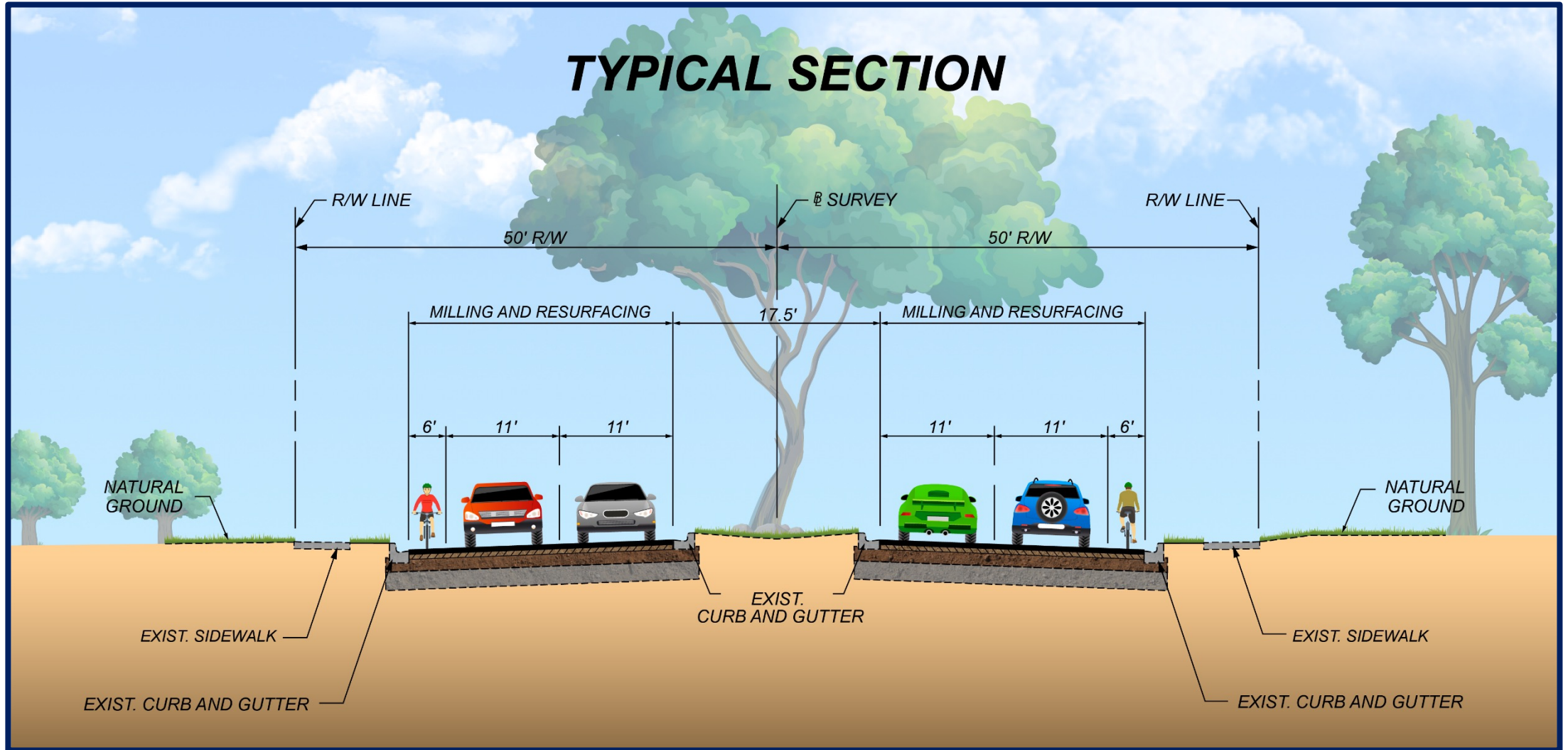

Construction Impacts

Construction Impacts

- Work will be performed primarily during daytime hours
- Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects of construction on the community
- Access to properties adjacent to the corridor will be maintained throughout construction
- Bicycle traffic will be maintained using shared lane markings
- Pedestrian detours will be provided to maintain connectivity

Construction Impacts

Temporary Traffic Control Plan

Closures/Detours:

- Existing 35 MPH speed limit will remain
- Limited lane closures (*one lane per direction at a time*) will occur during paving operations
 - Daytime
 - Bicycle traffic maintained on the road using shared lane markings
- Sidewalk closures will occur; however, pedestrians will be detoured to always maintain sidewalk connectivity
- Closures will be clearly delineated

What to Expect During Construction



Dust:

The contractor will be required to water and sweep in order to minimize construction-related dust



Noise:

Some noise should be expected during daytime hours



Access:

Access to businesses and residential properties will be maintained at all times during construction

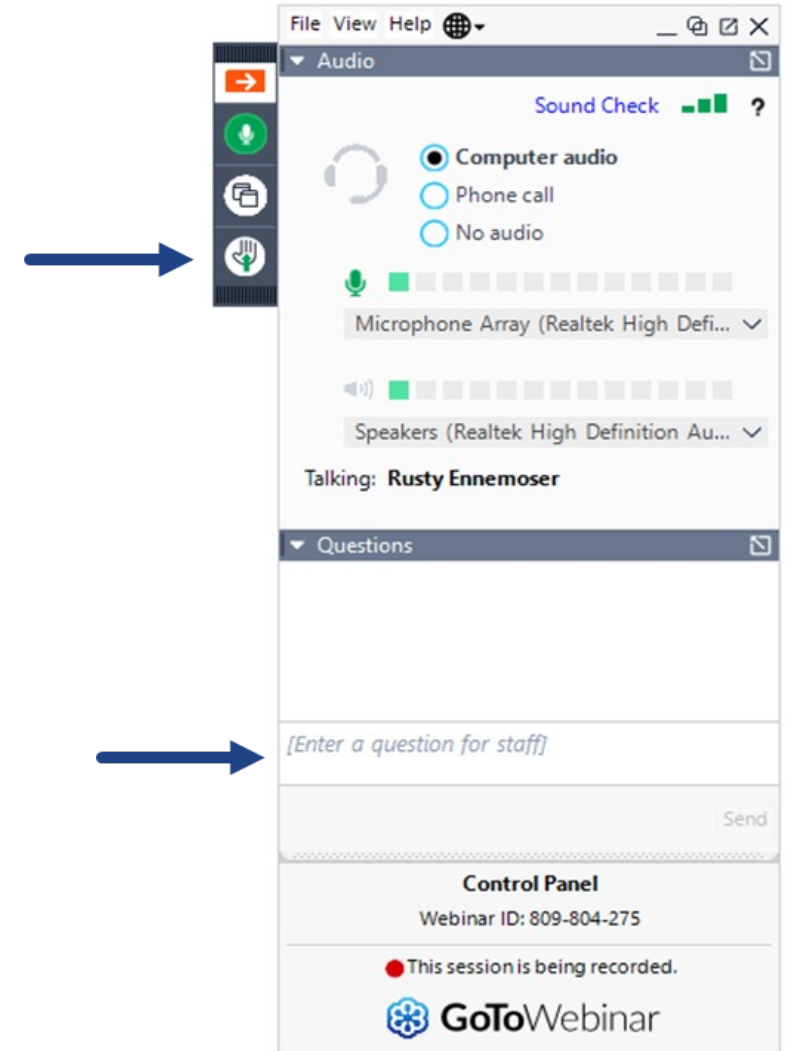
- ❑ Estimated Construction Start: Winter 2024
- ❑ Estimated Construction End: Spring 2026
- ❑ Estimated Construction Cost: \$2.2 million
