artin Luther King Jr. Boulevard at I-95 will undergo a full closure, in both directions, nightly, 11:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday night through Tuesday, through November, for bridge construction. Eastbound MLK Jr. Boulevard traffic will be detoured via NW 16 Avenue, N. Andrews Avenue, Atlantic Boulevard, and NW 6th Avenue. Westbound MLK Jr. Boulevard traffic will be detoured via NW 6th Avenue, Atlantic Boulevard, N. Andrews Avenue and NW 16 Avenue. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

This \$154 million, 8-mile project began construction on October, 2016 and is expected to be completed in spring 2020, weather permitting. Work is being performed by Prince Contracting, Inc., with HNTB Corporation administering the construction contract for the Florida Department of Transportation.
