



# HALLANDALE BEACH BOULEVARD IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT IN WEST PARK AND PEMBROKE PARK

---

## Project Overview

The Florida Department of Transportation awarded a \$6,616,134.01 contract to Community Asphalt, Corp., for roadway improvements along Hallandale Beach Boulevard from east of SR 7/US 441 to Lake Shore Drive in West Park and Pembroke Park. The length of the project is approximately 2 miles. Construction will begin January 3, 2017 and is expected to be completed by Fall 2018.

## Project Improvements

- Adding new drainage along project corridor
- Removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway within project limits
- Installing new traffic signal mast arms and pedestrian countdown timers at the following intersections: SW 56th Avenue and SW 40th Avenue
- Installing 4-foot bike lanes throughout the project limits

## Traffic Impact

- Continuous lane closures will occur in each direction of Hallandale Beach Boulevard from SR 7/US 441 to Lake Shore Drive throughout the duration of this project. One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction at all times.
- A short-term full closure of SW 32nd Avenue south of Hallandale Beach Boulevard will occur. An alternate route will be provided for northbound and southbound traffic.
- A short-term full closure of SW 40th Avenue south of Hallandale Beach Boulevard will occur. An alternate route will be provided for northbound and southbound traffic.
