

Project Overview

The Florida Department of Transportation has awarded a \$597,014 contract to Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc. to improve the Broward Boulevard Park and Ride Lot in Fort Lauderdale. Construction will begin August 24, 2015 and is expected to be completed in early 2016.

Project Improvements

- Removing old asphalt and resurfacing five parking areas within the Broward Boulevard Park and Ride Lot
- Upgrading signs and pavement markings
- Installing 888 concrete bumper guards

Schedule

Crews will work on one lot at a time in the following order:

Parking Lot #1 - 43 days Parking Lot #2 - 22 days Parking Lot #3 - 21 days Parking Lot #4 - 24 days Parking Lot #5 - 51 days



The phasing order and corresponding timeline is subject to change.

Traffic Impact

No lane closures are expected to complete this work. During each phase, the corresponding parking lot will be closed. When the contractor is ready to progress to the next phase, any vehicles left overnight in the parking lot will be towed.

In order to minimize impacts to Broward County Transit and Tri-Rail users, construction hours are as follows:

Monday through Friday 11 p.m. - 5 a.m. - asphalt resurfacing and concrete bumper guard installation 9:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. - upgrading concrete ramps to meet ADA requirements at lots 3, 4, and 5

Saturday and Sunday 10 p.m. - 6 a.m. - asphalt resurfacing and concrete bumper guard installation
