

NW NEIGHBORHOOD PHASE III PEDESTRIAN ENHANCEMENTS PROJECT IN FORT LAUDERDALE

Project Overview

The Florida Department of Transportation has awarded a \$1.4 million contract to Russell Engineering, Inc. to improve NW 15th Way, NW 7th Street, and NW 15th Terrace in Fort Lauderdale. Construction will begin September 28, 2015 and is expected to be completed in summer 2016.

Project Limits

- NW 15th Way from Sistrunk Boulevard / NW 6th Street to NW 7th Street
- NW 7th Street from NW 15th Way to NW 15th Terrace
- NW 15th Terrace from Sistrunk Boulevard / NW 6th Street to NW 7th Street

Project Improvements

- Adding sidewalk along both sides of the road
- Adding solar powered pedestrian lighting
- · Removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway
- Upgrading drainage structures
- Upgrading landscaping

Schedule

Crews anticipate working in the following order:

- NW 15th Way
- NW 7th Street
- NW 15th Terrace

Traffic Impact

All work for this project will be performed Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. Each road will be open to local traffic only while the contractor completes the work. Flaggers will assist with directing traffic as needed. Private vehicles must be kept out of the work zone during construction.
