



## OAKLAND PARK BOULEVARD IMPROVEMENTS FROM NW 31ST AVENUE TO EAST OF I-95 IN OAKLAND PARK

---

### Project Overview

The Florida Department of Transportation has awarded a \$3.2 million contract to Community Asphalt Corp. to make improvements along Oakland Park Boulevard from NW 31st Street to east of Interstate 95. Construction will begin January 25, 2016 and is expected to be completed by Fall 2016.

### Project Improvements

- Add new traffic signals, pedestrian crosswalks, and pedestrian signal countdown timers at NW 23rd Terrace
- Install irrigation sleeves for future landscape project in median along Oakland Park Boulevard
- Add drainage inlets along Oakland Park Boulevard
- Install traffic signals mast arms at NW 18th Avenue
- Remove old asphalt and resurface Oakland Park Boulevard within project limits
- Improve sidewalks and curb ramps to meet current ADA standards
- Add or replace signs and pavement markings

### Traffic Impact

- One lane in each direction of Oakland Park Boulevard within project limits may be closed during non-peak hours, between 9:00 AM and 4:00 PM.
- Up to two lanes in each direction of Oakland Park Boulevard within project limits may be closed during non-peak hours for paving operations between 9:00 PM and 7:00 AM.
