

CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE BROWARD MOBILITY PROJECT Broward



Project Overview

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has awarded a \$15 million contract to Construct Group Corp. for the construction of sidewalks, multi-use pedestrian paths, and bicycle lanes along 45 roadways in Broward County. Construction began February 2, 2015 and will be completed by Fall 2018. This project is part of a larger \$100 million investment from the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) to provide bicycle, pedestrian, and public transportation access throughout the Broward region. Project Improvements

Construction in Fort Lauderdale is expected to begin in January 2017 and be completed in early spring 2017.

SW 4 Avenue from SW 34 Street / North Perimeter Road to Broward Boulevard

- Removing old asphalt and resurfacing the road to provide 4 foot bike lanes in each direction, except from SW 6 Street to SW 2 Street where sharrow pavement markings will be applied to the existing roadway
- Reducing the existing speed limit from 40 mph to 35 mph

Traffic Impact

Single lane closures can be expected Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. and Sunday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m.
