

COMMERCIAL BOULEVARD AT ROCK ISLAND ROAD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT IN TAMARAC

Project Overview

The Florida Department of Transportation has awarded a \$449,999.99 contract to AUM Construction to improve the intersection of Commercial Boulevard at Rock Island Road in Tamarac. Construction will begin October 19, 2015 and is expected to be completed in early 2016.

Project Improvements

- Replacing traffic signals on span wire with mast arms on the southwest and southeast corners
- Constructing all new curb cut ramps to meet ADA standards
- Replacing existing in-ground loop vehicle detectors with video vehicle detectors

Traffic Impact

The contractor will work Monday through Saturday between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m.

No lane closures will occur during peak hours as follows:

Eastbound Commercial Boulevard — 6:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.

Westbound Commercial Boulevard — 3 p.m. to 8 p.m.
