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BROWARD COUNTY TRAFFIC IMPACT REPORT
June 14 through June 21, 2013

FORT LAUDERDALE -- Construction and maintenance-related lane closures on state highways in Broward County are expected during the week of June 14 through June 21. Weather permitting, work will be done at the following locations throughout the county.

Construction Projects

1. LOCATION: I-95 from the Golden Glades Interchange in Miami-Dade County to Broward Boulevard in Broward County

Traffic Impact:

- Up to two southbound lanes will be closed on I-95 from north of Griffin Road to south of Hallandale Beach Boulevard, from Sunday, June 16, through Thursday, June 20, between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. One lane will close at 9 p.m. and one additional lane will close at 11 p.m. At least two lanes will remain open at all times. All lanes will reopen by 5 a.m. Entrance and exit ramps will be closed as needed in the work zone. Detours will be clearly marked and electronic signs will advise drivers in advance.
- Up to two northbound lanes will be closed on I-95 from the Golden Glades Interchange in Miami-Dade County to Hollywood Boulevard in Broward County, from Sunday, June 16, through Thursday, June 20, between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. One lane will close at 9 p.m. and one additional lane will close at 11 p.m. At least two lanes will remain open at all times. All lanes will reopen by 5 a.m. Entrance and exit ramps will be closed as needed in the work zone. Detours will be clearly marked and electronic signs will advise drivers in advance.
- Up to two northbound lanes will be closed on I-95 from the Golden Glades Interchange in Miami-Dade County to Hollywood Boulevard in Broward County from 11 p.m. Friday, June 14, to noon, Saturday, June 15, for sign installation. One lane will close at 11 p.m. and one additional lane will close at midnight. At least two lanes will

remain open at all times. Traffic entering northbound I-95 from NW 167th Street will merge onto northbound I-95 sooner than usual during this closure.

- The exit ramp from southbound I-95 to Ives Dairy Road will be closed as needed and traffic will be detoured for roadwork from Sunday, June 16, through Thursday, June 20, between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. Drivers going south on I-95 who want to exit at Ives Dairy Road should continue south to Miami Gardens Drive, go east on Miami Gardens Drive to the northbound I-95 entrance ramp, and go north on I-95 to exit at Ives Dairy Road. ***This ramp will not be closed when the northbound exit ramp to Ives Dairy Road is closed.**
- The exit ramp from northbound I-95 to Ives Dairy Road will be closed as needed and traffic will be detoured for roadwork from Sunday, June 16, through Thursday, June 20 between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. Drivers going north on I-95 who want to exit at Ives Dairy Road should continue south to Miami Gardens Drive, go east on Miami Gardens Drive to the northbound I-95 entrance ramp, and go north on I-95 to exit at Ives Dairy Road. ***This ramp will not be closed when the southbound exit ramp to Ives Dairy Road is closed.**
- The entrance ramp from Ives Dairy Road to northbound I-95 will be closed as needed and traffic will be detoured for roadwork from Sunday, June 16, through Thursday, June 20, between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. Drivers who want to go north on I-95 will go south on I-95 to Miami Gardens Drive and east on Miami Gardens Drive to the northbound I-95 entrance ramp.
- The entrance ramp from Ives Dairy Road to southbound I-95 will be closed as needed and traffic will be detoured for roadwork from Sunday, June 16, through Thursday, June 20, for roadwork between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. Drivers who want to go south on I-95 will go north on I-95 to Hallandale Beach Boulevard and west on Hallandale Beach Boulevard to the southbound I-95 entrance ramp.
- Up to two eastbound or westbound lanes on Hollywood Boulevard at I-95 will be closed as needed for bridge work from Sunday, June 16, through Thursday, June 20, between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. At least one lane will remain open at all times.
- Up to two eastbound or westbound lanes on Stirling Road at I-95 will be closed as needed for bridge work from Sunday, June 16, through Thursday, June 20, between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. At least one lane in each direction will remain open during these closures.

Description: This project will extend the High Occupancy Toll Express lanes from northern Miami-Dade County north 13 miles to Fort Lauderdale. The project includes installing Intelligent Transportation System components; modifying the Ives Dairy Road interchange; bridge widening at specific locations and installing new noise barrier walls at locations between Hollywood Boulevard and Taft Street.

Cost/Completion: The construction cost is \$106 million. Completion is expected late 2014.

2. Eller Drive east of the I-595/US 1 interchange at Port Everglades

Traffic Impact:

- Intermittent lanes may be closed in either direction within the project limits Monday through Friday at all times.
- One eastbound lane on I-595 entering Port Everglades will be closed as needed Monday through Friday between 7 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

Description: A new overpass is being built over Eller Drive and the Port Everglades Railroad. The project includes reconstruction of several ramps in the I-595/US 1/ Eller Drive interchange, reconstruction of the Eller Drive intersections at NE 7th Avenue, NE 14th Avenue and McIntosh Road, installation of new railroad tracks and crossing signals, drainage retention ponds, moving utilities out of the construction path, concrete pavement roadway construction, highway lighting system, landscaping and irrigation.

Cost/Completion: \$42.5 million. Completion is expected winter 2014.

3. State Road 820 (Hollywood Boulevard) from State Road 7/US 441 to 44th Avenue in Hollywood

Traffic Impact:

- One lane in each direction on Hollywood Boulevard will be closed periodically Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.

Description: Major drainage and roadway improvements being made include: Removing the old asphalt and repaving Hollywood Boulevard throughout the project limits, installation of a new drainage system, shoulder widening for bike lanes in each direction, adding a raised median with curb, new decorative highway lighting system, sidewalk improvements and adding ADA ramps at intersections and driveways, adding pedestrian countdown times at crosswalks, adding new video detection at traffic signals, planting landscaping in the new median and along both sides of the road.

Cost/Completion: \$5.8 million construction contract. Completion is expected in November 2013.

4. Broward County Advanced Transportation Management System (ATMS) Project in Fort Lauderdale/Oakland Park/Wilton Manors/Lauderhill/Lauderdale Lakes/Sunrise/Plantation

Traffic Impact:

- One southbound lane on SR 7/US 441 at NW 11th Street will be closed Sunday, June 16, through Tuesday, June 18, between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- One northbound lane on SR 7/US 441 at NW 11th Street will be closed Sunday, June 16, through Tuesday, June 18, between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- One southbound lane on SR 7/US 441 at NW 29th Street will be closed Wednesday, June 19, through Friday, June 21, between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- One northbound lane on SR 7/US 441 at NW 29th Street will be closed Wednesday, June 19, through Friday, June 21, between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- One westbound lane on Broward Boulevard at East Acre Drive will be closed Wednesday, June 19, through Friday, June 21, between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- One eastbound lane on Broward Boulevard at East Acre Drive will be closed Wednesday, June 19, through Friday, June 21, between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- One westbound lane on Broward Boulevard at NW 18th Avenue will be closed Wednesday, June 19, through Friday, June 21, between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- One westbound lane on Broward Boulevard at SW 24th Avenue will be closed Wednesday, June 19, through Friday, June 21, between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- One eastbound lane on Broward Boulevard at SW 24th Avenue will be closed Wednesday, June 19, through Friday, June 21, between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.

Description: Project improvements include installation of fiber optic communications infrastructure, closed circuit TV cameras, Arterial Dynamic Message Signs, emergency pre-emption system devices, microwave vehicle detection system and travel time system.

Cost/Completion: \$8.9 million. Completion is expected in Fall 2013.

5. Griffin Road from I-75 Interchange to Weston Road in Southwest Ranches/Weston/Davie

Traffic Impact:

- One outside lane in each direction on Griffin Road will be closed Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

Description: Project improvements include re-aligning the exit ramp from southbound I-75 to westbound Griffin Road re-aligning the entrance ramp from westbound Griffin Road to southbound I-75, installing a new traffic signal on Griffin Road at the re-aligned southbound ramps, repaving ramps and roadway within project limits, installing new signs, installing new drainage, planting new landscape along the re-aligned southbound exit ramps

Cost/Completion: \$2.1 million. Completion is expected in June 2013.

6. I-95 at Davie Boulevard, Broward Boulevard, State Road 84 and I-595 Interchange in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- All lanes are open through June 21.

Description: This project includes sealing 13 bridge decks with an epoxy overlay.

Cost/Completion: \$3.8 million. Completion is expected in June 2013.

7. State Road 820 (Pines Boulevard) from US 27 to University Drive in Pembroke Pines

Traffic Impact:

- All lanes are open through June 21.

Description: This project includes the removal and replacement of high mast lights along the north side of Pines Boulevard.

Cost/Completion: \$889,489. Completion is expected in June 2013.

8. Broward County Advanced Transportation Management System (ATMS) Project in Hollywood/Pembroke Pines/Hallandale Beach/ West Park/Pembroke Park

Traffic Impact:

- All lanes are open through June 21.

Description: Project improvements include installation of fiber optic communications infrastructure, closed circuit TV cameras, Arterial Dynamic Message Signs, emergency pre-emption system devices, microwave vehicle detection system and travel time system.

Cost/Completion: \$5.3 million. Completion is expected in Fall 2014.

9. A1A between NE 14 Court and NE 18 Street in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- The roadway repairs and construction of the new sea wall have been completed.
- The new configuration of A1A in this area has one southbound bike lane, one southbound travel lane, a center turn lane, one northbound travel lane and one

northbound bike lane. The area between the new low curb and sea wall is open for pedestrian and recreational use. **There is no parking on the east side of A1A in this area.** The sidewalk and parallel parking on the west side of A1A are open.

- The speed limit has returned to 30 MPH.

Description: Emergency repairs are being made to A1A in this area. Crews are bringing in equipment and removing sections of the concrete wall and sidewalk that were damaged during Hurricane Sandy in October and the Thanksgiving weekend storms in November. FDOT plans to install sheet pile along the eastern edge of the damaged portion of A1A to stabilize the road.

Cost/Completion: The emergency contract is \$8.3 million. This project has been completed.

10. Rehabilitation of the Fort Lauderdale Train Station in Fort Lauderdale/Broward County

Traffic Impacts:

- No lane closures anticipated for this project.

Description: Project improvements include upgrades to existing station exterior to withstand adverse weather conditions - particularly wind, water and moisture, improve accessibility to and from the existing train station, renovate inside of train station to meet ADA requirements and upgrade the aesthetic and appearance of train station lobby.

Cost/Completion: \$1.08 million. Completion is expected in February 2014.

11. State Road 7/US441 at Prospect Road in Fort Lauderdale/Tamarac

Traffic Impacts:

- All lanes are open through June 21.

Description: Project improvements include installation of new signals and overhead illuminated signs.

Cost/Completion: \$228,522. Completion is expected in August 2013.

12. Broward Boulevard at Kentucky Avenue in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impacts:

- All lanes are open through June 21.

Description: Project improvements include installation of new signals and overhead illuminated signs.

Cost/Completion: \$228,522. Completion is expected in September 2013.

13. Las Olas Boulevard Bridge from SE25th Avenue to A1A in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impacts:

- One lane in each direction on the bridge will be closed through the summer 2013. One lane in each direction will remain open at all times
- The southbound lane on Birch Road at Las Olas Boulevard will be closed at all times through the summer 2013. Traffic will be detoured to Seabreeze Boulevard via Banyan Street.

Description: This bridge rehabilitation project includes the reconstruction of bridge concrete decks, replacement of bridge joints, installation of new pedestrian railings, installation of new traffic railings, installation of aluminum sidewalks along the movable portions of the bridge, painting the interior and exterior of bridge and the bridge tender house and repaving and restriping Las Olas Boulevard within the project limits.

Cost/Completion: \$5.8 million. Completion is expected in early 2014.

14. SR7/US441 from Holmberg Road to Palm Beach County Line in Coconut Creek/Parkland

Traffic Impacts:

- One northbound lane on SR 7/U.S. 441 will be partially closed Monday through Friday at all times.
- One lane in each direction on SR 7/U.S. 441 will be closed intermittently Monday through Friday between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.

Description: This project includes the repaving and restriping of SR7/US44, upgrading curb and ramps to meet ADA requirements, install new drainage, installing on traffic signals new video detection systems, installing pedestrian countdown timers at signalized intersections.

Cost/Completion: \$1.5 million. Completion is expected in Fall 2013.

15. Pines Boulevard from SW 196th Avenue and SW 150th Avenue in Pembroke Pines

Traffic Impacts:

- One eastbound lane on Pines Boulevard will be closed intermittently Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

Description: Project improvements include repaving the project limits, adding continuous bike lanes throughout the project, upgrading curb and ramps to meet ADA requirements, constructing and repairing sidewalks, installing on traffic signals new video detection systems, installing pedestrian countdown timers at signalized intersections, installing new signs and installing new drainage.

Cost/Completion: \$4.1 million. Completion is expected in early 2014.

16. Las Olas Isles and Sunrise Key Bridges Replacement in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impacts:

- One lane on the Fiesta Way Bridge will be closed Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.
- One westbound lane on Las Olas Boulevard at the Fiesta Way Bridge will be closed Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

Description: Project improvements include the demolition and replacement of the five low level bridges off Las Olas Boulevard to Royal Palm Drive, Nurmi Drive, Fiesta Way and Isle of Venice and the low level Sunrise Key Bridge off NE 6th Court.

Cost/Completion: \$8 million. Completion is expected in late 2016.

17. Hollywood Boulevard from South 64th Way to North 61st Avenue in Hollywood

Traffic Impacts:

- One lane in each direction on Hollywood Boulevard will be closed Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m.

Description: Project improvements include repaving the project limits, implementing new bike lanes, upgrading intersections to meet ADA requirements, upgrading pedestrian signals, installing minor drainage and restriping roadway.

Cost/Completion: \$531,126. Completion is expected in Fall 2013.

18. SR84 over I-95 Interchange in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impacts:

- The westbound middle lane on SR 84 will be closed at all times, except Monday through Friday between 4 p.m. and 7 p.m.

Description: Emergency project improvements include the repair of concrete barrier wall along westbound SR84 over I-95.

Cost/Completion: \$93,890. Completion is expected in Summer 2013.

Maintenance & Permit Projects:**19. US 1 near Port Everglades & Fort Lauderdale/Hollywood International Airport**

- All northbound and southbound lanes on US 1 are shifted to the east between Griffin Road and the Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport interchange for construction of the new runway through summer 2013.
- One northbound and one southbound lane on US 1 are closed at the I-595 interchange for construction at the airport through summer 2013. 20. Stirling Road from NW67th Avenue to just east of Davie Road

- One eastbound outside lane on Stirling Road will be closed at all times through May 2014 for the installation of a force main.

21. Pines Boulevard from NW 101th Avenue to NW 160th Avenue in Pembroke Pines

- One lane in each direction on Pines Boulevard will be closed at all times through July 2013 between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.

22. 14th Street Causeway Bridge over the Intracoastal Waterway in Pompano Beach

- The eastbound right lane will be closed Wednesday between 9 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. for maintenance.

23. Florida Police and Fire Games Triathlon in Fort Lauderdale

- All lanes on A1A from south of SE15th Street to north of Sunrise Boulevard will be closed Saturday morning during the event.
