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BROWARD COUNTY TRAFFIC IMPACT REPORT November 29 through December 6, 2013

FORT LAUDERDALE -- Construction and maintenance-related lane closures on state highways in Broward County are expected during the week of November 29 through December 6, according to the Florida Department of Transportation. **During the Thanksgiving holiday, there will be no construction-related lane closures Wednesday night, November 27, through Sunday night, December 1.** Weather permitting, work will be done at the following locations throughout the county.

CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

1. <u>I-95 from the Golden Glades Interchange in Miami-Dade County to Broward</u> <u>Boulevard in Broward County</u>

Traffic Impact:

- Up to three northbound lanes on I-95 from the Golden Glades Interchange in Miami-Dade County to Sunrise Boulevard in Broward County will be closed overnight Monday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. and Friday and Saturday between 11 p.m. and 7 a.m. At least two lanes will remain open at all times. Entrance and exit ramps will be closed as needed in the work zone. Detours will be clearly marked and electronic signs will advise drivers in advance.
- Up to three southbound lanes on I-95 from Sunrise Boulevard in Broward County to the Golden Glades Interchange in Miami-Dade County will be closed overnight Monday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. and Friday and Saturday between 11 p.m. and 7 a.m. At least two lanes will remain open at all times. Entrance and exit ramps will be closed as needed in the work zone. Detours will be clearly marked and electronic signs will advise drivers in advance.
- The southbound lanes on I-95 from Ives Dairy Road to Miami Gardens Drive in Miami-Dade County will be closed Wednesday, December 4, and Friday, December 6, between 1 a.m. and 5 a.m. for overhead sign installation. The entrance

ramp from Ives Dairy Road to southbound I-95 also will be closed. Motorists can use the following detours:

- Drivers going south on I-95 can exit at Ives Dairy Road, go west to State Road 7/NW 2nd Avenue and go south to the southbound I-95 entrance ramp.
- Drivers on Ives Dairy Road who want to go south on I-95 can go west to State Road 7/NW 2nd Avenue and south to the southbound I-95 entrance ramp.
- All eastbound and westbound lanes on Pembroke Road at I-95 will be closed and traffic will be detoured around-the-clock from 11 p.m., Friday, Dec. 6, through 3 a.m., Sunday, Dec. 8, for bridge work. Drivers going north on I-95 to go west on Pembroke Road and drivers going south on I-95 to go east on Pembroke Road will also be detoured. During these closures the following detours will be in use:
 - Westbound Pembroke Road through traffic: Go north on US 1 to Hollywood Boulevard, west on Hollywood Boulevard to SR 7 and south on SR 7 to Pembroke Road.
 - Westbound Pembroke Road to southbound I-95: Go north on US 1 to Hollywood Boulevard and west on Hollywood Boulevard to the southbound I-95 entrance ramp.
 - Eastbound Pembroke Road through traffic: Go north on SR 7 to Hollywood Boulevard, east on Hollywood Boulevard to US 1 and south on US 1 to Pembroke Road.
 - Eastbound Pembroke Road to northbound I-95: Go north on SR 7 to Hollywood Boulevard and east on Hollywood Boulevard to the northbound I-95 entrance ramp.
 - Southbound I-95 exit to eastbound Pembroke Road: Exit at Hollywood Boulevard and go east to US 1 and south on US 1 to Pembroke Road.
 - Northbound I-95 exit to westbound Pembroke Road: Exit at Hollywood Boulevard and go west to SR 7 and south on SR 7 to Pembroke Road.
- Up to two eastbound or westbound lanes on Hallandale Beach Boulevard will be closed at I-95 as needed for bridge work Monday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. At least one lane will remain open at all times in each direction.

Description: This project will extend the High Occupancy Toll Express lanes from northern Miami-Dade County north 13 miles to Fort Lauderdale. The project includes installing Intelligent Transportation System components; modifying the Ives Dairy Road interchange; bridge widening at specific locations and installing new noise barrier walls at locations between Hollywood Boulevard and Taft Street.

Cost/Completion: The construction cost is \$106 million. Completion is expected late 2014.

2. I-75 from north of Griffin Road to I-595 in Broward County

Traffic Impact:

• One northbound lane from south of 36th Street to Royal Palm Boulevard may be closed Monday, December 2, through Wednesday, December 4, between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. to collect survey data.

• One northbound lane from Royal Palm Boulevard to Indian Trace may be closed Thursday, December 5, and Friday, December 6, between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. to collect survey data.

Description: This 4.7-mile project will add four tolled managed lanes in the I-75 median. The work is part of the I-75 Express Lanes project that extends from NW 170th Street in northern Miami-Dade County to I-595 in Broward County. This project includes entrance and exit access points to the express lanes; a bridge with a direct connection to 595 Express; integrated Intelligent Transportation System and tolling components; noise barrier walls at various locations and new signage, lighting, drainage and landscaping improvements. **Cost/Completion:** Construction cost is \$75 million. Completion is expected in late 2016.

3. <u>Eller Drive east of the I-595/US 1 interchange at Port Everglades</u> Traffic Impact:

- Intermittent lanes may be closed in either direction within the project limits Monday through Friday at all times.
- One eastbound lane of I-595 entering Port Everglades will be closed as needed Monday through Friday between 7 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

Description: A new overpass is being built over Eller Drive and the Port Everglades Railroad. The project includes reconstruction of several ramps in the I-595/US 1/Eller Drive interchange, reconstruction of the Eller Drive intersections at NE 7th Avenue, NE 14th Avenue and McIntosh Road, installation of new railroad tracks and crossing signals, drainage retention ponds, moving utilities out of the construction path, concrete pavement roadway construction, highway lighting system, landscaping and irrigation.

Cost/Completion: \$42.5 million. Completion is expected November 2014.

4. <u>State Road 820 (Hollywood Boulevard) from State Road 7/US 441 to 44th Avenue in</u> <u>Hollywood</u>

Traffic Impact:

• One lane in each direction of Hollywood Boulevard will be closed periodically Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.

Description: Major drainage and roadway improvements being made include: Removing the old asphalt and repaving Hollywood Boulevard throughout the project limits, installation of a new drainage system, shoulder widening for bike lanes in each direction, adding a raised median with curb, new decorative highway lighting system, sidewalk improvements and adding ADA ramps at intersections and driveways, adding pedestrian countdown times at crosswalks, adding new video detection at traffic signals, planting landscaping in the new median and along both sides of the road.

Cost/Completion: \$5.8 million construction contract. Completion is expected in November 2013.

5. Broward County Advanced Transportation Management System (ATMS) Project in Fort Lauderdale/Oakland Park/Wilton Manors/Lauderhill/Lauderdale Lakes/Sunrise/Plantation

Traffic Impact:

• All lanes are open through December 6.

Description: Project improvements include installation of fiber optic communications infrastructure, closed circuit TV cameras, Arterial Dynamic Message Signs, emergency preemption system devices, microwave vehicle detection system and travel time system. **Cost/Completion:** \$8.9 million. Completion is expected in Fall 2013.

6. <u>Broward County Advanced Transportation Management System (ATMS) Project</u> <u>in Hollywood/Pembroke Pines/Hallandale Beach/ West Park/Pembroke Park</u>

Traffic Impact:

• All lane are open through December 6.

Description: Project improvements include installation of fiber optic communications infrastructure, closed circuit TV cameras, Arterial Dynamic Message Signs, emergency preemption system devices, microwave vehicle detection system and travel time system. **Cost/Completion:** \$5.3 million. Completion is expected in Fall 2014.

7. <u>Rehabilitation of the Fort Lauderdale Train Station in Fort Lauderdale/Broward</u> <u>County</u>

Traffic Impacts:

• No lane closures are anticipated for this project.

Description: Project improvements include upgrades to existing station exterior to withstand adverse weather conditions - particularly wind, water and moisture, improve accessibility to and from the existing train station, renovate inside of train station to meet ADA requirements and upgrade the aesthetic and appearance of train station lobby.

Cost/Completion: \$1.08 million. Completion is expected in February 2014.

8. <u>State Road 7/US441 at Prospect Road in Fort Lauderdale/Tamarac</u>

Traffic Impacts:

• All lanes are open through December 6.

Description: Project improvements include installation of new signals and overhead illuminated signs.

Cost/Completion: \$52,225. Completion is expected in fall 2013.

9. Broward Boulevard at Kentucky Avenue in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impacts:

All lanes are open through December 6.

Description: Project improvements include installation of new signals and overhead illuminated signs.

Cost/Completion: \$228,522. Completion is expected in fall 2013.

10. <u>East Las Olas Boulevard Bridge from SE25th Avenue to A1A in Fort Lauderdale</u> Traffic Impacts:

• Two lanes are closed at all times for construction through spring 2014. One lane in each direction will remain open at all times.

Description: This bridge rehabilitation project includes the reconstruction of bridge concrete decks, replacement of bridge joints, installation of new pedestrian railings, installation of new traffic railings, installation of aluminum sidewalks along the movable portions of the bridge,

painting the interior and exterior of bridge and the bridge tender house and repaving and restriping Las Olas Boulevard within the project limits.

Cost/Completion: \$5.8 million. Completion is expected in spring 2014.

11. <u>US27 from Griffin Road to Broward County/Palm Beach County Line in Southwest</u> <u>Ranches/Weston</u>

Traffic Impacts:

• All lanes are open through December 6.

Description: This project involves the deployment of an Intelligent Transportation Safety (ITS) System, which will include a wireless communication network, closed circuit television, cameras, dynamic message signs, highway advisory radio systems, citizens band radio advisory system, road weather information systems, environmental sensor stations, vehicle and speed detection systems and an electrical power sub-system.

Cost/Completion: \$4.58 million. Completion is expected in November 2013.

12. <u>Pines Boulevard from SW 196th Avenue and SW 150th Avenue in Pembroke Pines</u> Traffic Impacts:

- One lane in each direction of Pines Boulevard from SW 196th Avenue to SW 150th Avenue will be closed intermittently Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.
- Two lanes in each direction of Pines Boulevard from SW 196th Avenue to SW 150th Avenue will be closed intermittently overnight Sunday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Description: Project improvements include repaying the project limits, adding continuous bike lanes throughout the project, upgrading curb and ramps to meet ADA requirements, constructing and repairing sidewalks, installing on traffic signals new video detection systems, installing pedestrian countdown timers at signalized intersections, installing new signs and installing new drainage.

Cost/Completion: \$4.1 million. Completion is expected in early 2014.

13. <u>Bridges of the Isles and Sunrise Key Bridges Replacement in Fort Lauderdale</u> Traffic Impacts:

All lanes are open through December 6.

Description: Project improvements include the demolition and replacement of the five low level bridges off Las Olas Boulevard to Royal Palm Drive, Nurmi Drive, Fiesta Way and Isle of Venice and the low level Sunrise Key Bridge off NE 6th Court.

Cost/Completion: \$8 million. Completion is expected in Summer 2015.

14. <u>Hollywood Boulevard at North 35th Avenue in Hollywood</u>

Traffic Impacts:

• All lanes are open through December 6.

Description: Project improvements include upgrading signals and ramps to ADA standards. **Cost/Completion:** \$222,168. Completion is expected in the Fall 2013.

15. <u>Powerline Road at NW 40th Court in Deerfield Beach</u> Traffic Impacts:

• All lanes are open through December 6.

Description: Project improvements include installing a new signalized intersection. **Cost/Completion:** \$248,117. Completion is expected in the Fall 2013.

16. <u>I-95 Bridge Painting and Rehabilitation over the South Fork of the New River in</u> <u>Fort Lauderdale</u>

Traffic Impacts:

- The shoulder along northbound I-95 from SR 84/Marina Mile Boulevard to Davie Boulevard will be closed through December 23.
- The shoulder along southbound I-95 from Davie Boulevard to SR 84/Marina Mile Boulevard will be closed through December 23.
- The shoulder along the southbound I-95 exit ramp to both directions of I-595 will be closed through December 23.

Description: Project improvements include the repair, rehabilitation and painting of the three I-95 bridges over the South Fork of the New River.

Cost/Completion: \$18 million. Completion is expected in the Summer 2014.

17. <u>Kingfisher Waterway Bridge Replacement in Lighthouse Point</u>

Traffic Impacts:

• The bridge is closed to all traffic through the summer 2014. Southbound traffic is detoured to NE 21st Avenue via NE 33rd Street and then back to NE 23rd Avenue via NE 30th Court. Northbound traffic is detoured to NE 21st Avenue via NE 31st Street and then back to NE 23rd Avenue via NE 34th Street.

Description: Project improvements include replacing the bridge over Kingfisher Waterway, installing new drainage, upgrading curb and ramps to ADA requirements, and constructing and repairing sidewalks.

Cost/Completion: \$1.2 million. Completion is expected in the Summer 2014.

18. <u>Dixie Highway at McNab Road and SW 3rd Street in Pompano Beach</u> Traffic Impacts:

- One lane in each direction of McNab Road at Dixie Highway will be closed Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.
- One lane in each direction of SW 3rd Street at Dixie Highway will be closed Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.
- One lane in each direction of Dixie Highway at McNab Road and at SW 3rd Street will be closed Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.

Description: Project improvements include installing new mast arms, signs and pavement markings.

Cost/Completion: \$649,340. Completion is expected in early 2014.

19. <u>Traffic Signal Pivotal Hangers Project in Broward County</u>

Traffic Impacts:

• All lanes are open through December 6.

Description: Project improvements include installing new traffic signal pivotal hangers at various intersections throughout Broward County.

Cost/Completion: \$689,978. Completion in Late 2013.

20. Pembroke Road at 31st Avenue in Pembroke Park

Traffic Impacts:

• One lane in each direction at the intersection of Pembroke Road and 31st Avenue will be closed intermittently Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.

Description: Project improvements include repaying, installing a new signal at the intersection of Pembroke Road and SW 31st Avenue, upgrading curb and ramps to meet ADA requirements, installing pedestrian countdown timers, and making lane changes on westbound Pembroke Road. **Cost/Completion:** \$318,566. Completion in Fall 2013.

21. University Drive at Miramar Parkway in Miramar

Traffic Impacts:

- One lane in each direction at the intersection of University Drive and Miramar Parkway will be closed Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- One lane in each direction at the intersection of University Drive and Miramar Parkway will be closed intermittently overnight Sunday through Thursday between 6 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Description: Project improvements include installing signs, installing new pedestrian features, installing guardrail, improving lighting, relocating utilities, and paving project limits. **Cost/Completion:** \$604,987. Completion in Winter 2013.

22. <u>I-595 Mobility Hub in Davie</u>

Traffic Impact:

• All lanes open through December 6.

Description: Project improvements include constructing a new transit mobility hub and parkand-ride lot with bus bays for 595 Express Bus Service and South Florida Education Center (SFEC) Tri-Rail Shuttle, adding drainage structures, installing lighting, signs, pavement markings, and landscaping within the facility.

Cost/Completion: \$1.2 million. Completion in early 2014.

23. <u>I-95/I-595 Interchange Landscaping in Fort Lauderdale / Dania Beach</u> Traffic Impact:

• No lane closures anticipated for this project.

Description: Project improvements include constructing tiered landscaped planters at several locations within the project limits, constructing two ponds to assist with drainage, and installing a temporary irrigation system.

Cost/Completion: \$5.9 million. Completion in Spring 2014.

24. <u>A1A Drainage Improvements from Meade Street to Oak Street in Hollywood</u> Traffic Impact:

• Oak Street at A1A will be closed from 7 a.m. Monday, December 2, to 5 p.m. Tuesday, December 3. Motorists travelling on A1A will be directed to travel east on Elm Street and south on Surf Road to access Oak Street. To exit Oak Street, motorists will be directed to travel south on Surf Road and west on Franklin Street to access A1A. This full closure is necessary to install drainage structures on Oak Street.

• One lane of A1A between Perry Street and Franklin Street will be closed Tuesday through Friday between 7 p.m. and 10:30 a.m. Flag crews will maintain two-way traffic.

Description: Project Improvements include installing new drainage upgrades that will connect to the existing drainage system, removing old asphalt and repaying A1A within the project limits, replacing existing sidewalk along the west side with a new 6-foot wide sidewalk with curb and gutter.

Cost/Completion: \$749,294. Completion in Spring 2014.

25. <u>CSX Bridge Replacement over the South Fork of the New River in Fort Lauderdale</u> Traffic Impact:

• All lanes open through December 6.

Description: Project improvements include replacing the existing South Florida Rail Corridor CSX Railroad rolling lift bridge just west of I-95 over the south fork of the New River in Fort Lauderdale.

Cost/Completion: \$22 million. Completion in Spring 2016.

26. <u>Andrews Avenue Extension Reconstruction in Pompano Beach</u> Traffic Impact:

- One lane in each direction of Andrews Avenue from NW 18th Street to Copans Road will be closed intermittently Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.
- One lane in each direction of Copans Road from NW 15th Avenue to the South Florida Rail Corridor will be closed intermittently Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

Description: Project improvements include reconstructing Andrews Avenue Extension from NW 18th Street to north of Copans Road, widening and repaving Andrews Avenue Extension within the project limits, changing roadway access on Andrews Avenue Extension, restriping Andrews Avenue Extension within the project limits, installing new overhead signal arms, installing new drainage, upgrading curb and ramps to ADA requirements, constructing and repairing sidewalks, installing new lighting, installing new signals at intersections within the project limits, and installing new signs.

Cost/Completion: \$6.6 million. Completion in Summer 2015.

27. Sheridan Street from CSX Railroad to North 26th Avenue

Traffic Impact:

- Two lanes in each direction of Sheridan Street from the CSX railroad to North 26th Avenue will be closed overnight Sunday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- One eastbound lane of Sheridan Street from the CSX railroad to North 26th Avenue will be closed Monday through Friday between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.

Description: Project improvements include removing old asphalt and repaving Sheridan Street within the project limits, except within the I-95 interchange upgrading existing traffic signals to mast arms, upgrading pedestrian features including curbs and ramps to meet ADA standards, and improving drainage.

Cost/Completion: \$3.9 million. Completion in Fall 2014.

28. <u>Sunrise Boulevard Bridge over the Middle River</u>

Traffic Impact:

• All lanes are open through December 6.

Description: Project improvements include replacing the replacing the Sunrise Boulevard Bridge over the Middle River, increasing the bridge clearance by approximately 4 feet, relocating utilities, installing new lighting, signalization, and pavement markings. Cost/Completion: \$9.5 million. Completion in early 2016.

29. <u>A1A Roadway Improvements Project in Pompano Beach / Hillsboro Beach</u> Traffic Impact:

- One lane in each direction of A1A at 1800 S Ocean Boulevard north of Coral Reef Drive in Pompano Beach will be closed intermittently Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- One lane in each direction of A1A at SE 8th Street in Pompano Beach will be closed intermittently Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- One lane in each direction of A1A at NE 5th Street in Pompano Beach will be closed intermittently Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- One lane in each direction of A1A at NE 10th Street in Pompano Beach will be closed intermittently Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- One lane in each direction of A1A at the entrance to the Overlook Condominium south of Hillsboro Boulevard in Hillsboro Beach will be closed intermittently Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m.

Description: Project improvements include adding crosswalks at five intersections and midblock crossings in Pompano Beach and Hillsboro Beach.

Cost/Completion: \$43,000. Completion in late 2013.

MAINTENANCE & PERMIT PROJECTS

30. US 1 near Port Everglades & Fort Lauderdale/Hollywood International Airport

- All northbound and southbound lanes of US 1 are shifted to the east between Griffin Road and the Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport interchange for construction of the new runway through fall 2013.
- One northbound and one southbound lane of US 1 are closed at the I-595 interchange for construction at the airport through fall 2013.
