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FDOT Broward County Traffic Impact Report

April 14 through April 21, 2017

FORT LAUDERDALE – Construction and maintenance-related lane closures on state highways in Broward County are expected during the week of April 14 through April 21. **Weather permitting**, work will be done at the following locations throughout the county. INTERSTATE CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

1. I-95 from south of Broward Boulevard to north of Commercial Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- Three northbound lanes of I-95 will be closed Monday through Thursday, with the first lane closing at 10:30 p.m., the second lane closing at 11:30 p.m. and the third lane closing at 12:30 a.m. until 5 a.m. All lanes will be open by 5:30 a.m.
- Three lanes of I-95 southbound will be closed Sunday through Thursday, beginning Monday, April 17 through Thursday, April 20 with the first lane closing at 10:30 p.m., the second lane closing at 11:30 p.m. and the third lane closing at 12:30 a.m. until 5 a.m. All lanes will be open by 5:30 a.m.
- The I-95 northbound exit ramps to Sunrise Boulevard will be closed Monday through Thursday between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via Oakland Park Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 northbound entrance ramps from Sunrise Boulevard will be closed Monday through Thursday between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Powerline Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 northbound exit ramps to Oakland Park Boulevard will be closed Monday through Thursday between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via Commercial Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- Advanced Notice: The northbound I-95 Express lanes will be completely closed to traffic beginning at Ives Dairy Road, 10:30 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Thursday night, April 27, for lane modification work.
- Advanced Notice: The northbound I-95 Express lanes, beginning at Ives Dairy Road, will undergo a full closure, around the clock, 9 p.m., Friday night, April 28 until 5 a.m. Monday morning, May 1, for lane modification work.
- Advanced Notice: One lane of I-95 northbound, from south of Stirling Road to Marina Mile Boulevard, will be closed 10:30 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Thursday night, April 27.
- Advanced Notice: One lane of I-95 northbound, from south of Stirling Road to Marina Mile Boulevard, will be closed, around the clock, 9 p.m., Friday night, April 27 to 5 a.m., Monday morning, May 1.

Description: This project will extend the High Occupancy Toll lanes from south of Broward Boulevard to north of Commercial Boulevard in Broward County. The scope of work includes adding a lane and converting the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lanes to create two express lanes in each direction. Other work includes: installing Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and

tolling equipment; widening bridges; and installing noise barrier walls at locations along I-95 Southbound between Broward Boulevard and NW 6th Street, and along I-95 Northbound between Powerline Road and Commercial Boulevard. Cost/Completion: Construction cost is \$149 million. Completion is expected in spring 2020.

2. I-95 from north of Commercial Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale to south of SW 10th Street in Deerfield Beach

Traffic Impact:

- Three lanes of northbound I-95 between Commercial Boulevard and SW 10th Street will be closed Sunday through Thursday, with the first lane closing at 10:30 p.m., the second lane closing at 11:30 p.m. and the third lane closing at 12:30 a.m. until 5:30 a.m.
- Three lanes of southbound I-95 between SW 10th Street and Commercial Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday with the first lane closing at 10:30 p.m., the second lane closing at 11:30 p.m. and the third lane closing at 12:30 a.m. until 5:30 a.m.
- Two lanes of Atlantic Boulevard in each direction from Dixie Highway to Andrews Avenue will be closed nightly, Sunday night through Thursday night between 10:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. and daily, 9 a.m. until 3 p.m., Monday through Friday.
- The I-95 southbound exit ramp to westbound Atlantic Boulevard is closed through fall 2017 for ramp reconstruction. Traffic is detoured to a new temporary ramp just south of the closed ramp.
- The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from eastbound Atlantic Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via North Andrews Avenue. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from westbound Atlantic Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via South Andrews Way and I-95. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The southbound exit ramp to Cypress Creek Road will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Commercial Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from westbound Cypress Creek Road will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via North Andrews Way and I-95. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

Description: This project will extend the High Occupancy Toll lanes from north of Commercial Boulevard to south of SW 10th Street in Broward County. The scope of work includes adding a lane and converting the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lanes to create two express lanes in each direction. Other work includes: installing Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and tolling equipment; widening bridges; and installing noise barrier walls at locations along I-95 northbound between Atlantic Boulevard and Sample Road, and along I-95 southbound north of Sample Road. Contract time for this \$154 million project began **Friday, January 8, 2016**, with design activities currently underway. Construction began Sunday, August 14, 2016. Cost/Completion: Construction cost is \$154 million. Completion is expected in spring 2020.

3. I-75 from NW 170th Street in Miami-Dade County to I-595 in Broward County

Traffic Impact:

- **Segments A&B (NW 170th Street in Miami-Dade County to South of Miramar Parkway in Broward County):**

This week in Segment AB, construction crews continued building and paving the future I-75 Express Lanes within the existing median. Crews also continued constructing the new direct connect bridge over Florida's Turnpike. A full closure of northbound Florida's Turnpike and the northbound I-75 on ramp from Florida's Turnpike is scheduled to occur today from 11 p.m. to 3 a.m. These closures are for sign structure removal operations. A press release and E-blast was sent out last Friday, April 7, to notify the traveling public. Barrier walls, and ITS construction activities also took place this week, and crews performed two double lane closures (Tuesday, April 11 and Wednesday, April 12) along Florida's Turnpike northbound for drainage operations.

- **Segment C (South of Miramar Parkway to South of Sheridan Street):**

Phase three construction along Miramar Parkway continued this week. Ramps construction also took place along the Miramar Parkway interchange, and crews also continued grading and leveling the ponds at Miramar Parkway and Pines Boulevard interchanges. Construction work along the C-4 Canal also continued, and construction crews continued to build and pave the future Express Lanes within the existing I-75 median. A full closure of all eastbound and westbound lanes along Miramar Parkway at Dykes and SW 148 Avenue, is scheduled to take place Tuesday, April 18. This closure will be for overhead sign structure installation. A press release and E-blast will be sent out tomorrow to notify the public.

- **Segment D (South of Sheridan Street to North of Griffin Road):**

Construction to build and pave the future I-75 Express Lanes within the existing median continued this week. Crews also continued phase 3A construction along the Sheridan Street interchange. Additionally, barrier wall, ITS, drainage and light pole base operations also continued to take place.

- **Segment E (North of Griffin Road to I-595):**

Construction crews continued addressing punch list items along the corridor. A full continuous closure of the I-595 Express lanes ramp from eastbound I-595 is scheduled to take place 2 a.m. Tuesday, April 18 to 1 p.m. Sunday, April 23 for sign structure operations. The press release and E-blast will be distributed this Friday, April 14.

- **Segment E (I-75 Northbound Lane Balancing Project):**

Punch list items continued to be addressed along this section of the corridor. Construction crews also performed full ramp closures to safely address some of these items. The northbound on ramp of I-75 to Naples was closed Sunday, April 9, and eastbound I-595 ramp from northbound I-75 was closed on Monday, April 10. Both closures occurred between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5 a.m. Press releases and maps were distributed last week Friday to notify the public. Additionally, final incentive/disincentive of the project was accepted yesterday, April 12.

Description: This 15-mile project will add four tolled managed lanes in the I-75 median from NW 170th Street in northern Miami-Dade County to I-595 in Broward County. The work will be completed in four segments to minimize the impact to the public. This project includes entrance and exit access points to the express lanes; a bridge with a direct connection to 595 Express; integrated Intelligent Transportation System and tolling components; noise barrier walls at various locations and new signage, lighting, drainage and landscaping improvements. Cost/Completion: Construction cost is \$481 million. Completion is expected in mid-2019.

NORTHEAST BROWARD CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

4. A1A Improvements Project from Oakland Park Boulevard to Flamingo Avenue in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- Northbound traffic is shifted slightly west to the center of the road. Southbound traffic is on the west side of the road. Traffic will remain in this configuration through April 2017 while the contractor completes the reconstruction of the east side of the road. Two lanes in each direction will be maintained unless otherwise noted.
- Access from northbound Galt Ocean Drive to A1A will be restricted through April/May 2017. Motorists may access A1A via NE 41 Street, NE 36 Street, and NE 35 Street.
- One northbound lane of A1A from Oakland Park Boulevard to Flamingo Avenue may be intermittently closed Monday through Friday between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. for drainage improvements.

- The crosswalk at NE 34 Street will be closed through June when the business access road along the east side of the road is completed and the new sidewalk is constructed. While this crosswalk is closed, pedestrians will be directed to use the crosswalks at NE 32nd Street and NE 36th Street.
- The contractor will be working on drainage structures within the business access drive aisle from NE 33 Street to NE 36 Street Sunday through Thursday evenings between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. During this time, access to the business access drive aisle may be restricted.

Description: Project improvements include removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway within the project limits, upgrading sidewalks and ramps to meet ADA requirements, repairing, adjusting, and replacing drainage structures throughout the project limits, upgrading the following existing intersections to mast arm signals: 34th Street, mid-block between 36th and 40th Street, and at 40th Street, upgrading all existing pedestrian signals to countdown timers, upgrading signs and pavement markings throughout the project limits, including adding a 1.5 foot striped buffer to separate the four foot wide bike lanes from the outside vehicle travel lane, upgrading existing lighting along the corridor to lighting with a variable intensity function that can be accessed remotely in order to cause minimal disruption to sea turtles during their nesting season, adding elevated roadway lighting and lower level lighting to illuminate the sidewalk, and adding a business access drive aisle along the east side of road between NE 34th and NE 36th Street. 5. A1A Improvements Project from East of the Mercedes River Bridge to Sunrise Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- One lane in each direction of A1A from the Fort Lauderdale Beach Park entrance to Vistamar Street may be closed between 9 p.m. and 4 p.m. Sunday through Friday for the installation of in-roadway lighting and pavement markings as well as other miscellaneous operations.
- One lane in each direction of Sunrise Boulevard from the Intracoastal Bridge to A1A may be closed between 9 p.m. and 4 p.m. Sunday through Friday for concrete removal, curb and gutter installation, signalization improvements, and installation of pavement markings.

Description: The improvements under this project consist of removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway within the project limits, upgrading sidewalks and ramps to meet ADA requirements, upgrading all existing pedestrian signals to countdown timers, upgrading signs and pavement markings throughout the project limits, widening Sunrise Boulevard to accommodate four-foot wide bike lanes in each direction, modifying pavement striping and markings to provide shared use or dedicated bike lanes on A1A, and adding in-roadway lighting at several crosswalks. 6. NW 9th Avenue / Powerline Road Improvements Project from Broward Boulevard to NW 6th Street / Sistrunk Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- NW 9th Avenue / Powerline Road from Broward Boulevard to NW 3 Street will be open to local traffic only Monday through Friday between 7 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. for resurfacing. Motorists will be detoured to NW 7 Avenue or NW 11 Avenue.

Description: Project improvements include removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway and upgrading signs and pavement markings, upgrading crosswalk ramps to meet ADA requirements and upgrading existing pedestrian signals, adding sharrows (share the road arrows) to the travel lane in each direction from NW 1st Street to NW 4th Street, widening the existing roadway to add six-foot wide bike lanes in each direction from NW 4th Street to NW 6th Street / Sistrunk Boulevard, adding pedestrian solar lighting, adding new concrete curb and gutter and improving roadway drainage system, constructing new eight-foot wide sidewalks, upgrading existing traffic signals to pole mounted signals, and improving landscaping. 7. Broward Boulevard Improvements and Bridge Replacement Project in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- The sidewalk along the north side of Broward Boulevard between NW 18 Avenue and NW 15 Avenue is closed. Detour signs are in place to guide pedestrians.
- Westbound traffic is shifted slightly north and will use the 3-lane temporary bridge for the duration of construction.
- Up to two lanes in each direction of Broward Boulevard from US 1 to NW 18 Avenue (500 feet maximum at a time) will be closed between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. for drainage improvements, widening, curb and gutter installation, and sidewalk construction.
- The sidewalk along the north side of Broward Boulevard from US 1 to NW 18 Avenue may be closed intermittently between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. for drainage improvements and widening. Signs will be in place to direct pedestrians to the south sidewalk as needed.
- The outside lane in each direction of the cross streets on either side of Broward Boulevard from NW 3 Avenue / Nugent Avenue to NW 11 Avenue may be closed Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. for the installation of traffic signal foundations on Broward Boulevard. Crews will only work at one cross street at a time.

Description: Project improvements include replacing the bridge over the North Fork of the New River, removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway, upgrading crosswalk ramps to meet ADA requirements, upgrading signs and pavement markings, relocating bus shelters, adding roadway lighting, installing drainage structures, upgrading signalized intersections to mast arms, reconstructing sidewalks, and widening roadway to add bike lanes in each direction. 8. Hillsboro Boulevard Improvements Project from Military Trail to US 1 in Deerfield Beach

Traffic Impact:

- One lane in each direction of Hillsboro Boulevard from Military Trail to US 1 will be closed daily Monday, April 3 through Wednesday, May 3 between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. for sidewalk, drainage, and signalization improvements and sign installation.
- The outside eastbound lane of Hillsboro Boulevard from Military Trail to SW 1 Terrace will be closed through late April for widening, signalization, and sidewalk improvements.
- The outside lane of eastbound Hillsboro Boulevard from I-95 to SW 3 Avenue / Martin Luther King Jr. Avenue will be closed Monday, March 27 through late April for widening, signalization, and sidewalk improvements.
- **Beginning Thursday, April 20, the right lane of eastbound Hillsboro Boulevard approaching Military Trail will be a right-turn only lane through June 2017.**

Description: Project improvements include improving the off-ramp from northbound I-95 to eastbound Hillsboro Boulevard including adding a new signalized intersection and adding second lane to increase capacity, relocating and upgrading drainage structures, upgrading crosswalk ramps to meet ADA requirements, constructing new stamped asphalt crosswalks from east of Natura Boulevard to US 1, upgrading existing pedestrian signals to countdown timers, upgrading signalized intersections to mast arms, installing new decorative lighting, constructing new medians east of SE 2 Avenue, removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway, upgrading signs and pavement markings to reflect the new roadway configuration as follows: (1) Military Trail to Dixie Highway - Three 11-foot lanes in each direction (2) NE / SE 2 Avenue to US 1 - Two 11-foot lanes in each direction, and adding a bike lane or sharrows in each direction as follows: (1) Military Trail to NW/SW 2 Terrace - 4-foot bike lane (2) NW / SW 2 Terrace to NE / SE 2 Avenue - Sharrows symbols to designate that the outside travel lane will be shared with vehicles (3) NE / SE 2 Avenue to US 1 - 7-foot bike lane. 9. Powerline Road Improvements Project from Sunrise Boulevard to NW 29 Street in Fort Lauderdale and Wilton Manors

Traffic Impact:

- One lane in each direction of Powerline Road from Sunrise Boulevard to NW 29 Street will be closed Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. for work on the sidewalk and curb ramps.
- One lane in each direction of Powerline Road from Sunrise Boulevard to NW 29 Street will be closed Sunday through Thursday evening between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. for resurfacing.
- A sidewalk will be maintained on at least one side of the road within the project limits. Signage will be in place to guide pedestrians through the work zone.

Description: Project improvements include removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway, constructing new sidewalks, upgrading crosswalk ramps to meet ADA requirements, upgrading drainage structures, upgrading existing pedestrian signals to countdown timers, and upgrading signs and pavement markings to reflect the new roadway configuration which includes two 11-foot wide travel lanes and a 6-foot wide bike lane separated by a 3.5-foot wide buffer in each direction. 10. Broward Mobility Project

Traffic Impact:

- Northbound traffic will be shifted toward the center of the road along SW 130 Avenue from SW 14 Street to SW 8 Street in Davie Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. for excavation and shoulder widening. One lane in each direction will be maintained.

Description: The improvements under this contract include constructing sidewalks, multi-use pedestrian paths, and bicycle lanes along 45 roadways in Broward County within Hollywood, Pembroke Pines, Davie, Plantation, Deerfield Beach, Pompano Beach, Lauderhill, Oakland Park, Lauderdale Lakes, and Fort Lauderdale. 11. Hillsboro Boulevard over Florida's Turnpike Pedestrian Bridge Rehabilitation Project in Coconut Creek and Deerfield Beach

Traffic Impact:

- The outside westbound lane of Hillsboro Boulevard at Florida's Turnpike will be closed Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- The outside westbound lane of Hillsboro Boulevard at Florida's Turnpike will be closed Sunday through Thursday evenings between 6 p.m. and 9 p.m.
- Two outside lanes of westbound Hillsboro Boulevard at Florida's Turnpike will be closed Sunday through Thursday evenings between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- The sidewalk along the north side of Hillsboro Boulevard over Florida's Turnpike will be closed through late March. Pedestrians will be detoured to the sidewalk on the south side of the road at NW 39 Avenue and NW 45 Avenue.
- Two lanes in each direction of Florida's Turnpike at Hillsboro Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday evening between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Description: The improvements under this contract include replacing the pedestrian fencing on both the north and the south sides of the Hillsboro Boulevard Bridge over Florida's Turnpike. 12. SE 17 Street at SE 15 Avenue Intersection Improvements Project in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impacts:

- **One lane** in each direction of SE 17 Street at SE 15 Avenue may be closed Monday through Thursday evenings between 7:30 p.m. and 11:30 a.m. for signalization improvements.

Description: The improvements under this contract include removing existing asphalt and resurfacing the intersection, installing a new signalized intersection with mast arms, adding crosswalks on both sides of the intersection to provide access across SE 17 Street, installing two new street lights at the intersection, and installing eight countdown pedestrian signals. 13. Old Dixie Highway Improvements Project from NE 13th Street to the end of the Middle River Bridge in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impacts:

- The northbound lane of Old Dixie Highway may be closed from NE 14th Place to NE 16th Court between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Flaggers will be directing traffic through the work zone. Motorists may expect delays.
- **“No Thru Trucks” signs have been installed at each end of the project limits along Old Dixie Highway.**

14. CSX Bridge Replacement over the South Fork of the New River in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- The outside shoulder of the eastbound I-595 exit ramp to northbound I-95 will be closed through early 2017.
- There will be intermittent interruptions in the channel while contractor performs some activities with the bridge in the lowered position. The bridge will be opened when a vessel approaches, but there may be some slight delays.

Description: Project improvements include replacing the existing SFRC CSX Railroad rolling lift bridge just west of I-95 over the south fork of the New River in Fort Lauderdale. 16. A1A Sidewalk and Lighting Improvements Project in Hallandale Beach

Traffic Impact:

- One lane in each direction of A1A from the Hallandale Beach Boulevard to County Line Road may be closed Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.
