#### **INTERSTATE CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS**

## 1. <u>I-95 from south of Broward Boulevard to north of Commercial Boulevard in Fort</u> Lauderdale

- Three northbound lanes of I-95 will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 10:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. The first lane will close at 10:30 p.m., the second lane at 11:30 p.m. and the third lane at 12:30 a.m. until 5 a.m. All lanes will be open by 5:30 a.m.
- Three southbound lanes of I-95 will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 10:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. The first lane will close at 10:30 p.m., the second lane closing at 11:30 p.m. and the third lane closing at 12:30 a.m. until 5 a.m. All lanes will be open by 5:30 a.m.
- The I-95 northbound exit ramps to Oakland Park Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via Commercial Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 northbound entrance ramps from Oakland Park Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Powerline Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

- The I-95 northbound exit ramps to Commercial Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Cypress Creek Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 northbound entrance ramps from Commercial Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via Powerline Road and Cypress Creek Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 northbound exit ramps to Sunrise Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via Oakland Park Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 northbound entrance ramps from Sunrise Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Powerline Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- Advance Notice: The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from Cypress Creek Road will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m., beginning Sunday, July 9. Traffic will be detoured via Andrews Avenue, Commercial Boulevard and I-95.
- Advance Notice: The I-95 southbound exit ramp to Commercial Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m., beginning Sunday, July 9. Traffic will be detoured via Oakland Park Boulevard and I-95.

**Description:** This project will extend the High Occupancy Toll lanes from south of Broward Boulevard to north of Commercial Boulevard in Broward County. The scope of work includes adding a lane and converting the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lanes to create two express lanes in each direction. Other work includes: installing Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and tolling equipment; widening bridges; and installing noise barrier walls at locations along I-95 Southbound between Broward Boulevard and NW 6<sup>th</sup>Street, and along I-95 Northbound between Powerline Road and Commercial Boulevard. **Cost/Completion:** Construction cost is \$149 million. Completion is expected in spring 2020.

# 2. <u>I-95 from north of Commercial Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale to south of SW 10<sup>th</sup> Street in Deerfield Beach</u>

- Three northbound lanes of I-95 between Commercial Boulevard and SW 10<sup>th</sup> Street will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 10:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. The first lane will close at 10:30 p.m., the second lane at 11:30 p.m. and the third lane at 12:30 a.m. until 5:30 a m
- Three southbound lanes of I-95 between SW 10<sup>th</sup> Street and Commercial Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 10:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. The first lane will close at 10:30 p.m., the second lane at 11:30 p.m. and the third lane at 12:30 a.m. until 5:30 a.m.
- The I-95 southbound exit ramp to westbound Atlantic Boulevard is completely closed through fall 2017. Traffic is detoured to a temporary ramp just south of the closed ramp.
- The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from eastbound Copans Road will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 11: 30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Sample Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Atlantic Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Copans Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from eastbound Atlantic Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via South Dixie Highway and Copans Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

- The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from westbound Atlantic Boulevard will be closed Sunday though Thursday night between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Cypress Creek Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- One eastbound lane of Atlantic Boulevard from Dixie Highway to Andrews Avenue will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 10:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. and Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m.
- One westbound lane of Atlantic Boulevard from Dixie Highway to Andrews Avenue will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 10:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. and Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m.
- One westbound lane of Martin Luther King Boulevard from NW 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue to NW 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue will be closed daily between 4 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- Advance Notice: The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from the Cypress Creek Road Park & Ride Lot will be closed around the clock beginning 11:30 p.m., Sunday, July 9 through 11:30 p.m., Thursday, July 20. Traffic will be detoured via West Cypress Creek Road or North Andrews Avenue and I-95. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

**Description:** This project will extend the High Occupancy Toll lanes from north of Commercial Boulevard to south of SW 10<sup>th</sup> Street in Broward County. The scope of work includes adding a lane and converting the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lanes to create two express lanes in each direction. Other work includes: installing Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and tolling equipment; widening bridges; and installing noise barrier walls at locations along I-95 northbound between Atlantic Boulevard and Sample Road, and along I-95 southbound north of Sample Road. Contract time for this \$154 million project began **Friday, January 8, 2016**, with design activities currently underway. Construction began Sunday, August 14, 2016. ## 3. I-95 Express Phase 2 Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) Retrofit

## **Traffic Impact:**

- Three inside lanes of I-95 southbound from north of Stirling Road to Sheridan Street and the 95 Express Lane entrance at Davie Boulevard will be closed Monday through Friday between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. The first lane will close at 9 p.m., the second lane at 11 p.m. and the third lane at 1:00 a.m. until 5 a.m. All lanes will be open by 5:30 a.m.
- The I-95 northbound exit ramp to I-595 will be closed Wednesday, June 28 between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. The first lane will close at 9 p.m. and the second lane at 11:30 p.m. All lanes will be open by 5:30 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via the northbound I-95 and Davie Boulevard.

**Description:** This project includes improvements of 95 Express Phase II Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) retrofit components, including overhead sign structures and signs along I-95 from the Miami-Dade County Line to south of I-595 in Broward County. Cost/Completion: Construction cost is \$900,000. Completion is expected in winter 2017.

## 4. <u>I-95 Interchange from Hillsboro Boulevard to SW 10<sup>th</sup> Street</u>

- The I-95 southbound exit ramp to SW 10<sup>th</sup> Street will be fully closed as needed Sunday through Friday between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. Motorists can detour via Hillsboro Boulevard.
- Traffic on the I-95 southbound exit ramp to SW 10<sup>th</sup> Street has been shifted to the east to accommodate the ramp widening.

- The outside lanes of I-95 southbound from Hillsboro Boulevard to SW 10<sup>th</sup> Street will be closed Sunday through Friday with the first lane closing at 9 p.m., the second lane closing at 10 p.m. and the third lane, if necessary, closing at 12:30 a.m. until 5 a.m.
- Two westbound lanes of SW 10<sup>th</sup> Street at I-95 will be closed Sunday through Friday between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- The sidewalk on the north side of SW 10<sup>th</sup> Street between SW 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue and SW Natura Boulevard is closed through August 2017. Signs are in place to direct pedestrians to the south sidewalk.

**Description:** This project consists of widening southbound I-95 to add an auxiliary lane from the Hillsboro Boulevard entrance ramp to the SW 10<sup>th</sup> Street exit ramp, widening the existing southbound I-95 exit ramp to SW 10<sup>th</sup> Street, addition of a free flow right turn lane to westbound SW 10<sup>th</sup> Street, widening of westbound SW 10<sup>th</sup> Street to add an acceleration lane, utility relocation, milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, installation of barrier walls, curbs, sidewalks, guardrail, drainage, overhead signs, signing and pavement markings, signals, lighting, and retaining walls. This is the first of five interchange improvement projects throughout Broward and Palm Beach Counties. Cost/Completion: Construction cost for all five projects is \$32.5 million. Completion in fall 2017.

## 5. I-75 from NW 170th Street in Miami-Dade County to I-595 in Broward County

- Segment A & B (NW 170<sup>th</sup> Street in Miami-Dade County to South of Miramar Parkway in Broward County)
  - Two southbound lanes of I-75 from Miami Gardens Drive to NW 170<sup>th</sup> Street will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
  - Two southbound lanes of I-75 from Florida's Turnpike to Miami Gardens Drive will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
  - Two southbound lanes of I-75 from Miramar Parkway to Florida's Turnpike will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.

    Two northbound lanes of I-75 from Florida's Turnpike to Miramar Parkway will be
  - closed Sunday through Thursday between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.
  - Two northbound lanes of I-75 from Miami Gardens Drive to Florida's Turnpike will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.
  - Two northbound lanes of I-75 from NW 170<sup>th</sup> Street to Miami Gardens Drive will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 8 p.m. and 4 p.m.
  - One lane in each direction of Florida's Turnpike from Red Road to I-75 will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.

    One lane in each direction of Florida's Turnpike from I-75 to Okeechobee Road will be
  - closed Sunday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
  - One northbound ramp lane of Florida's Turnpike from Okeechobee Road to I-75 will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.

    One southbound ramp lane of I-75 from Snake Creek Canal to Florida's Turnpike will be
  - closed Sunday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
  - One lane in each direction of I-75 from NW 170<sup>th</sup> Street to Florida's Turnpike will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.
  - The I-75 northbound entrance ramp from Florida's Turnpike will be closed Tuesday. June 27 through Saturday July 1 between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Motorists will be detoured to exit at US 27/Okeechobee Road (Exit 35), continue south on US 27/Okeechobee Road to NW 138th Street, east on NW 138th Street to Hialeah Garden Boulevard and take the northbound entrance ramp to I-75.
- Segment C (South of Miramar Parkway to South of Sheridan Street)

- One northbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to north of Miramar Parkway will be closed Monday through Friday between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to north of Miramar Parkway will be closed Monday through Friday between 11 a.m. and 3 p.m.
- One northbound lane of I-75 from south of Pines Boulevard to north of Pines Boulevard will be closed Monday through Friday between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from south of Pines Boulevard to north of Pines Boulevard may be closed Monday through Friday between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m.
- One northbound lane of I-75 from south of Pines Boulevard to north of Pines Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from south of Pines Boulevard to north of Pines Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 7 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- One northbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to south of Pines Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 8 p.m. and 3 p.m.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to south of Pines Boulevard will be closed Monday through Friday between 10 a.m. and 7 a.m.
- One northbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to Miramar Parkway will be closed Monday through Friday between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to Miramar Parkway will be closed Monday through Friday between 11 a.m. and 3 p.m.
- One northbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to Miramar Parkway will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to Miramar Parkway will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- One lane in either direction of Miramar Parkway at I-75 will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.

## • Segment D (South of Sheridan Street to North of Griffin Road)

- One lane in each direction of I-75 from south of Sheridan Street to north of Griffin Road may be closed Monday through Friday between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m.
- Two lanes in either direction of I-75 from south of Sheridan Street to north of Griffin Road may be closed Sunday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- One lane in each direction of Sheridan Street at I-75 may be closed Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m.
- Two lanes in either direction of Sheridan Street at I-75 may be closed Sunday through Thursday between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- The I-75 southbound exit ramp to westbound Sheridan Street (Exit 11B) will be closed from 10 p.m. Sunday, June 25 to 6 a.m. Monday, June 26 for ramp construction. Motorist will be detoured to exit at Sheridan Street East (Exit 11A), continue east on Sheridan Street to Flamingo Road and make a U-turn to go west on Sheridan Street. Please follow the posted detour. If necessary to complete the work, this ramp closure will also take place from 10 p.m. Monday, June 26 to 6 a.m. Tuesday, June 27.

## • Segment E (North of Griffin Road to I-595)

#### • Segment E (I-75 Northbound Lane Balancing Project)

• All lanes are open through Friday, June 30.

**Description:** This 15-mile project will add four tolled managed lanes in the I-75 median from NW 170<sup>th</sup> Street in northern Miami-Dade County to I-595 in Broward County. The work will be completed in four segments to minimize the impact to the public. This project includes entrance and exit access points to the express lanes; a bridge with a direct connection to 595 Express; integrated Intelligent Transportation System and tolling components; noise barrier walls at various locations and new signage, lighting, drainage and landscaping improvements. ## 6. <u>A1A Improvements Project from Oakland Park Boulevard to Flamingo Avenue in Fort Lauderdale</u>

## **Traffic Impact:**

- One lane in each direction of A1A from Oakland Park Boulevard to Flamingo Road may be closed intermittently at any time Monday through Friday for drainage improvements.
- The crosswalk at NE 34<sup>th</sup> Street is closed through June while the business access road along the
  east side of the road is completed and the new sidewalk is constructed. Pedestrians will be
  directed to use the crosswalks at NE 32<sup>nd</sup> Street and NE 36<sup>th</sup> Street.
- One lane in each direction of NE 41<sup>st</sup> Street, NE 36<sup>th</sup> Street or NE 35<sup>th</sup> Street from A1A to Galt Ocean Drive may be closed Monday through Friday between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. for reconstruction. A flag crew will direct traffic.
- The sidewalk along the east side of A1A from Flamingo Avenue to Oakland Park Boulevard will be closed through June for reconstruction. Pedestrian detour signs are in place.
- NE 35<sup>th</sup> Street from A1A to Galt Ocean Drive will be closed through Monday, June 26 for crosswalk reconstruction. Motorists will be detoured to NE 36<sup>th</sup> Street or NE 41<sup>st</sup> Street.

**Description:** Project improvements include removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway within the project limits; upgrading sidewalks and ramps to meet ADA requirements; repairing, adjusting, and replacing drainage structures throughout the project limits; upgrading the following existing intersections to mast arm signals: 34th Street, mid-block between 36th and 40th Street, and at 40th Street; upgrading all existing pedestrian signals to countdown timers; upgrading signs and pavement markings throughout the project limits, including adding a 1.5 foot striped buffer to separate the four foot wide bike lanes from the outside vehicle travel lane; upgrading existing lighting along the corridor to lighting with a variable intensity function that can be accessed remotely in order to cause minimal disruption to sea turtles during their nesting season; adding elevated roadway lighting and lower level lighting to illuminate the sidewalk, and adding a business access drive aisle along the east side of road between NE 34th and NE 36th Street. # 7. NW 9th Avenue / Powerline Road Improvements Project from Broward Boulevard to NW 6th Street / Sistrunk Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale

## **Traffic Impact:**

• All lanes are open through Friday, June 30.

**Description:** Project improvements include removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway and upgrading signs and pavement markings, upgrading crosswalk ramps to meet ADA requirements and upgrading existing pedestrian signals, adding sharrow pavement markings (share the road arrows) to the travel lane in each direction from NW 1st Street to NW 4th Street, widening the existing roadway to add six-foot wide bike lanes in each direction from NW 4th Street to NW 6th Street / Sistrunk Boulevard, adding pedestrian solar lighting, adding new concrete curb and gutter and improving roadway drainage system, constructing new eight-foot wide sidewalks, upgrading existing traffic signals to pole mounted signals, and improving landscaping. **Cost/Completion:** \$1.8 million. Completion in summer 2017.

## 8. Broward Boulevard Improvements and Bridge Replacement Project in Fort Lauderdale

## **Traffic Impact:**

- Westbound traffic is shifted slightly north and will use the three-lane temporary bridge for the duration of construction.
- Up to two lanes in each direction of Broward Boulevard from US 1 to NW 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue will be closed between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. and Saturdays between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. for drainage improvements, roadway widening, curb and gutter installation and sidewalk construction. The closures will be limited to 500 feet maximum at a time.
- The sidewalk along the north side of Broward Boulevard from NW 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue to NW 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue is closed. Detour signs are in place to guide pedestrians.
- The sidewalk along the north side of Broward Boulevard from US 1 to NW 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue is closed for utility improvements. Signs are in place to direct pedestrians to the south sidewalk as needed.
- The outside lane in each direction of the cross streets on either side of Broward Boulevard from NW 3rd Avenue / Nugent Avenue to NW 11th Avenue may be closed Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. for the installation of traffic signal foundations on Broward Boulevard. Crews will only work at one cross street at a time.

**Description:** Project improvements include replacing the bridge over the North Fork of the New River, removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway, upgrading crosswalk ramps to meet ADA requirements, upgrading signs and pavement markings, relocating bus shelters, adding roadway lighting, installing drainage structures, upgrading signalized intersections to mast arms, reconstructing sidewalks, and widening roadway to add bike lanes in each direction. #### 9. Hillsboro Boulevard Improvements Project from Military Trail to US 1 in Deerfield Beach

#### **Traffic Impact:**

- One lane in each direction of Hillsboro Boulevard from Military Trail to US 1 will be closed daily between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. through Monday, July 3 for sidewalk, drainage and signal improvements and sign installation.
- The outside lane of eastbound Hillsboro Boulevard from Military Trail to SW 1<sup>st</sup> Terrace will be closed through July for widening, sidewalk, drainage and signal improvements.
- The right lane of eastbound Hillsboro Boulevard before Military Trail will be a right-turn only lane through June. Two through lanes will remain open leading into the construction zone east of Military Trail.
- The outside lane of westbound Hillsboro Boulevard from Martin Luther King Jr. Avenue to NW 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue is closed through late June for drainage, widening, signal and sidewalk improvements.

**Description:** Project improvements include improving the off-ramp from northbound I-95 to eastbound Hillsboro Boulevard including adding a new signalized intersection and adding second lane to increase capacity; relocating and upgrading drainage structures; upgrading crosswalk ramps to meet ADA requirements; constructing new stamped asphalt crosswalks from east of Natura Boulevard to US 1; upgrading existing

pedestrian signals to countdown timers; upgrading signalized intersections to mast arms; installing new decorative lighting; constructing new medians east of SE 2 Avenue; and removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway. In addition, signs and pavement markings will be upgraded to reflect the new roadway configuration: from Military Trail to Dixie Highway, there will be three 11-foot travel lanes in each direction; from NE / SE 2 Avenue to US 1, there will be two 11-foot lanes in each direction. Also, bike lanes or sharrows (symbols to designate the outside travel lane will be shared by vehicles and bicycles) will be added as follows: from Military Trail to NW/SW 2 Terrace, there will be a 4-foot-wide bike lane; from NW / SW 2 Terrace to NE / SE 2 Avenue, sharrows in the outside travel lane will designate a shared lane; from NE / SE 2 Avenue to US 1, there will be a 7-foot-wide bike lane. ## 10. **Broward Mobility Project**

## **Traffic Impact:**

- Traffic lanes along SW 130<sup>th</sup> Avenue from State Road 84 to SW 14<sup>th</sup> Street in Davie will be narrowed and shifted toward the center of the road Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. for excavation and shoulder widening. One lane in each direction will be open.
