INTERSTATE CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

1. I-95 from south of Broward Boulevard to north of Commercial Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale

- Three northbound lanes of I-95 will be closed Sunday through Thursday, with the first lane closing at 10:30 p.m., the second lane closing at 11:30 p.m. and the third lane closing at 12:30 a.m. until 5 a.m. All lanes will be open by 5:30 a.m.
- One inside lane of I-95 southbound will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 10:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.
- The I-95 northbound exit ramps to Sunrise Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via Oakland Park Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 northbound entrance ramps from Sunrise Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Powerline Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

- The I-95 northbound exit ramps to Oakland Park Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. through Thursday night, April 6. Traffic will be detoured via Commercial Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 northbound entrance ramps from Oakland Park Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. through Thursday night, April 6. Traffic will be detoured via Commercial Boulevard and Powerline Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The outside lane in each direction of Broward Boulevard from SW 1st Street to SW 18th Street will be closed Monday through Thursday between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- One lane of the I-95 southbound entrance ramp from Broward Boulevard will be closed Monday through Thursday between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- Two lanes of the I-95 southbound exit ramp to Broward Boulevard will be closed Monday through Thursday between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Description: This project will extend the High Occupancy Toll lanes from south of Broward Boulevard to north of Commercial Boulevard in Broward County. The scope of work includes adding a lane and converting the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lanes to create two express lanes in each direction. Other work includes: installing Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and tolling equipment; widening bridges; and installing noise barrier walls at locations along I-95 Southbound between Broward Boulevard and NW 6thStreet, and along I-95 Northbound between Powerline Road and Commercial Boulevard. Cost/Completion: Construction cost is \$149 million. Completion is expected in spring 2020.

2. <u>I-95 from north of Commercial Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale to south of SW 10th Street in</u> Deerfield Beach

- Three lanes of northbound I-95 between Commercial Boulevard and SW 10th Street will be closed Sunday through Thursday, with the first lane closing at 10:30 p.m., the second lane closing at 11:30 p.m. and the third lane closing at 12:30 a.m. until 5:30 a.m.
- Three lanes of southbound I-95 between SW 10th Street and Commercial Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday with the first lane closing at 10:30 p.m., the second lane closing at 11:30 p.m. and the third lane closing at 12:30 a.m. until 5:30 a.m.
- The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from westbound Atlantic Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Cypress Creek Road. Florida Highway Patrol will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from eastbound Atlantic Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via South Dixie Highway and Copans Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The existing I-95 southbound exit ramp to Atlantic Boulevard will be closed around-the-clock for approximately six months, beginning 11:30 p.m., Sunday, March 19. Traffic will be detoured to a new temporary ramp just south of the existing ramp, which will open to traffic at 5 a.m. Monday, March 20. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from eastbound Atlantic Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via North Andrews Avenue. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from westbound Atlantic Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via South Andrews Way and I-95. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 southbound exit ramp to Cypress Creek Road will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Commercial Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from westbound Cypress Creek Road will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via North

- Andrews Way and I-95. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- Two lanes in each direction of Atlantic Boulevard from Dixie Highway to Andrews Avenue will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 10:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Description: This project will extend the High Occupancy Toll lanes from north of Commercial Boulevard to south of SW 10th Street in Broward County. The scope of work includes adding a lane and converting the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lanes to create two express lanes in each direction. Other work includes: installing Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and tolling equipment; widening bridges; and installing noise barrier walls at locations along I-95 northbound between Atlantic Boulevard and Sample Road, and along I-95 southbound north of Sample Road. Contract time for this \$154 million project began **Friday, January 8, 2016**, with design activities currently underway. Construction began Sunday, August 14, 2016. Cost/Completion: Construction cost is \$154 million. Completion is expected in spring 2020.

3. <u>I-95 Interchange from Hillsboro Boulevard to SW 10th Street</u>

Traffic Impact:

- The I-95 southbound exit ramp to SW 10th Street will be fully closed as needed Sunday through Friday between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. Motorists can detour via Hillsboro Boulevard.
- Traffic on the I-95 southbound exit ramp to SW 10th Street has been shifted to the east to accommodate the ramp widening.
- The outside lanes of I-95 southbound from Hillsboro Boulevard to SW 10th Street will be closed Sunday through Friday with the first lane closing at 9 p.m., the second lane closing at 10 p.m. and the third lane, if necessary, closing at 12:30 a.m. until 5 a.m.
- Two westbound lanes of SW 10th Street at I-95 will be closed Sunday through Friday between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- The sidewalk on the north side of SW 10th Street between SW 12th Avenue and SW Natura Boulevard is closed through April 2017. Signs are in place to direct pedestrians to the south sidewalk.

Description: This project consists of widening southbound I-95 to add an auxiliary lane from the Hillsboro Boulevard entrance ramp to the SW 10th Street exit ramp, widening the existing southbound I-95 exit ramp to SW 10th Street, addition of a free flow right turn lane to westbound SW 10th Street, widening of westbound SW 10th Street to add an acceleration lane, utility relocation, milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, installation of barrier walls, curbs, sidewalks, guardrail, drainage, overhead signs, signing and pavement markings, signals, lighting, and retaining walls. This is the first of five interchange improvement projects throughout Broward and Palm Beach Counties. Cost/Completion: Construction cost for all five projects is \$32.5 million. Completion in summer 2017.

4. <u>I-75 from NW 170th Street in Miami-Dade County to I-595 in Broward County</u>

- Segment A & B (NW 170 $^{\rm th}$ Street in Miami-Dade County to South of Miramar Parkway in Broward County)
 - Two southbound lanes of I-75 from Miami Gardens Drive to NW 170th Street will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
 - Two southbound lanes of I-75 from Florida's Turnpike to Miami Gardens Drive will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.

- Two southbound lanes of I-75 from Miramar Parkway to Florida's Turnpike will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- Two northbound lanes of I-75 from Florida's Turnpike to Miramar Parkway will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- Two northbound lanes of I-75 from Miami Gardens Drive to Florida's Turnpike will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- Two northbound lanes of I-75 from NW 170th Street to Miami Gardens Drive will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 8 p.m. and 4 p.m.
- One lane in each direction of Florida's Turnpike from Red Road to I-75 will be closed Monday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- One lane in each direction of Florida's Turnpike from I-75 to Okeechobee Road will be closed Monday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- One northbound ramp lane of Florida's Turnpike from Okeechobee Road to I-75 will be closed Monday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from Snake Creek Canal to Florida's Turnpike will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- One lane in each direction of I-75 from NW 170th Street to Florida's Turnpike will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- The I-75 northbound entrance ramp from Florida's Turnpike will be closed Sunday through Tuesday between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m. Motorists will be detoured to exit at US 27/Okeechobee Road (Exit 35) and go south on US 27/Okeechobee Road to NW 138th Street, east on NW 138th Street to Hialeah Garden Boulevard and take the northbound entrance ramp to I-75. If necessary to complete the work, these lane closures will also take place from 11 p.m. Tuesday to 5 a.m. Wednesday.

• Segment C (South of Miramar Parkway to South of Sheridan Street)

- One northbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to north of Miramar Parkway will be closed Monday through Friday between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to north of Miramar Parkway will be closed Monday through Friday between 11 a.m. and 3 p.m.
- One northbound lane of I-75 from south of Pines Boulevard to north of Pines Boulevard will be closed Monday through Friday between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from north of Pines Boulevard to south of Pines Boulevard may be closed Monday through Friday between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m.
- One northbound lane of I-75 from south of Pines Boulevard to north of Pines Boulevard will be closed Monday through Thursday between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from south of Pines Boulevard to north of Pines Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 7 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- One northbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to north of Miramar Parkway will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 8 p.m. and 3 p.m.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to north of Miramar Parkway will be closed Monday through Friday between 10 a.m. and 7 a.m.
- One northbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to Miramar Parkway will be closed Monday through Friday between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to Miramar Parkway will be closed Monday through Friday between 11 a.m. and 3 p.m.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to Miramar Parkway will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- One lane in each direction of Miramar Parkway at I-75 will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- The I-75 southbound exit ramp to eastbound Miramar Parkway will be closed from 5 a.m. Satueday to 5 a.m. Monday. Motorists will be detoured to exit at Pines Boulevard East (Exit 9A), go east on Pines Boulevard to Flamingo Road and south on Flamingo Road to Miramar Parkway.

• Segment D (South of Sheridan Street to North of Griffin Road)

• One lane in each direction of I-75 from south of Sheridan Street to north of Griffin Road may be closed Monday through Friday between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m.

- Two lanes in either direction of I-75 from south of Sheridan Street to north of Griffin Road may be closed Sunday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- One lane in each direction of Sheridan Street at I-75 may be closed Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m.
- Two lanes in either direction of Sheridan Street at I-75 may be closed Sunday through Thursday between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.

• Segment E (North of Griffin Road to I-595)

• All lanes are open through Friday, March 17.

• Segment E (I-75 Northbound Lane Balancing Project)

- Two northbound lanes of I-75 from north of Indian Trace along northbound Sawgrass Expressway and eastbound I-595 ramp will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6:30 a.m.
- Three northbound lanes of I-75 from north of Royal Palm Beach Boulevard to I-595 will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 7 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- Three northbound lanes of I-75 from north of Royal Palm Boulevard to north of Indian Trace will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 7 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- Two northbound lanes of I-75 from north of Royal Palm Boulevard to I-595 will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 9:30 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- Two northbound lanes of I-75 from north of Royal Palm Boulevard to north of Indian Trace will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 9:30 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- The eastbound ramp of I-595 from northbound I-75 will be closed intermittently Sunday through Friday between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m. Motorists will be detoured to exit at Royal Palm Boulevard (Exit 15) and go west on Royal Palm Boulevard to Weston Road, north on Weston Road to State Road 84 and east on SR 84 to enter I-595 eastbound just east of SW 136th Avenue. If necessary to complete the work, this closure will also take place Wednesday, March 15 through Friday, March 17 between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- All northbound lanes of I-75 (to Naples) from north of Royal Palm Boulevard will be closed Monday through Wednesday between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m. Motorists will be detoured to exit at Royal Palm Boulevard (Exit 15) and go west on Royal Palm Boulevard to Weston Road, north on Weston Road to State Road 84 and west on SR 84 to re-enter I-75 northbound. If necessary to complete the work, this closure will also take place Wednesday, March 15 through Friday, March 17 between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Description: This 15-mile project will add four tolled managed lanes in the I-75 median from NW 170th Street in northern Miami-Dade County to I-595 in Broward County. The work will be completed in four segments to minimize the impact to the public. This project includes entrance and exit access points to the express lanes; a bridge with a direct connection to 595 Express; integrated Intelligent Transportation System and tolling components; noise barrier walls at various locations and new signage, lighting, drainage and landscaping improvements. Cost/Completion: Construction cost is \$481 million. Completion is expected in mid-2019.

NORTHEAST BROWARD CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

5. <u>A1A Improvements Project from Oakland Park Boulevard to Flamingo Avenue in Fort</u> Lauderdale

- Northbound traffic is shifted slightly west toward the center of the road. Southbound traffic will remain on the west side of the road. Traffic will be in this configuration through March 2017, while the contractor completes the reconstruction of the east side of the road. Two lanes will be open in each direction.
- Access from northbound Galt Ocean Drive to A1A will be restricted through March 2017.
 Motorists may access A1A via NE 41st Street, NE 36th Street and NE 35th Street.
- One northbound lane of A1A from Oakland Park Boulevard to Flamingo Road may be closed Monday through Friday between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. for drainage improvements.
- The crosswalk at NE 34th Street is closed until April while the business access road along the east side of the road is completed and the new sidewalk is constructed. Pedestrians will be directed to use the crosswalks at NE 32nd Street and NE 36th Street.
- Access to the business drive aisle from NE 33rd Street to NE 36th Street may be restricted Sunday through Wednesday night between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. for drainage work.

Description: Project improvements include removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway within the project limits; upgrading sidewalks and ramps to meet ADA requirements; repairing, adjusting, and replacing drainage structures throughout the project limits; upgrading the following existing intersections to mast arm signals: 34th Street, mid-block between 36th and 40th Street, and at 40th Street; upgrading all existing pedestrian signals to countdown timers; upgrading signs and pavement markings throughout the project limits, including adding a 1.5 foot striped buffer to separate the four foot wide bike lanes from the outside vehicle travel lane; upgrading existing lighting along the corridor to lighting with a variable intensity function that can be accessed remotely in order to cause minimal disruption to sea turtles during their nesting season; adding elevated roadway lighting and lower level lighting to illuminate the sidewalk, and adding a business access drive aisle along the east side of road between NE 34th and NE 36th Street. Cost/Completion: \$9.3 million. Completion in summer 2017.

6. <u>A1A Improvements Project from East of the Mercedes River Bridge to Sunrise Boulevard in</u> Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- One lane in each direction of A1A from the Fort Lauderdale Beach Park entrance to Vistamar Street will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m. for roadway lighting installation and construction activities.
- One lane in each direction of Sunrise Boulevard from the Intracoastal Waterway Bridge to A1A will be closed Monday through Friday between 6 a.m. and 4 p.m. for roadwork.
- One lane in each direction of A1A from Fort Lauderdale Beach Park to Vistamar Street may be closed Monday through Friday between 4 p.m. and 6 a.m. for lighting improvements.

Description: The improvements under this project consist of removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway within the project limits, upgrading sidewalks and ramps to meet ADA requirements, upgrading all existing pedestrian signals to countdown timers, upgrading signs and pavement markings throughout the project limits, widening Sunrise Boulevard to accommodate four-foot wide bike lanes in each direction, modifying pavement striping and markings to provide shared use or dedicated bike lanes on A1A, and adding in-roadway lighting at several crosswalks. 7. NW 9th Avenue / Powerline Road Improvements Project from Broward Boulevard to NW 6th Street / Sistrunk Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

 NW 9th Avenue / Powerline Road from Broward Boulevard to NW 3rd Street will be open to local traffic only Monday through Friday between 7 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. for drainage improvements. Motorists will be detoured to NW 7th Avenue or NW 11th Avenue.

Description: Project improvements include removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway and upgrading signs and pavement markings, upgrading crosswalk ramps to meet ADA requirements and upgrading existing pedestrian signals, adding sharrow pavement markings (share the road arrows) to the travel lane in each direction from NW 1st Street to NW 4th Street, widening the existing roadway to add six-foot wide bike lanes in each direction from NW 4th Street to NW 6th Street / Sistrunk Boulevard, adding pedestrian solar lighting, adding new concrete curb and gutter and improving roadway drainage system, constructing new eight-foot wide sidewalks, upgrading existing traffic signals to pole mounted signals, and improving landscaping. Cost/Completion: \$1.8 million. Completion in summer 2017.

8. Broward Boulevard Improvements and Bridge Replacement Project in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- Westbound traffic is shifted slightly north and will use the three-lane temporary bridge for the duration of construction.
- Up to two lanes in each direction of Broward Boulevard from US 1 to NW 18th Avenue will be closed Monday through Friday between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. for drainage improvements and widening. The closures will be limited to 500 feet maximum at a time.
- The sidewalk along the north side of Broward Boulevard from NW 18th Avenue to NW 15th Avenue is closed. Detour signs are in place to guide pedestrians.
- The sidewalk along the north side of Broward Boulevard from US 1 to NW 18th Avenue may be closed intermittently between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. for drainage improvements and widening. Signs will be in place to direct pedestrians to the south sidewalk as needed.
- The outside lane in each direction of the cross streets on either side of Broward Boulevard from NW 3rd Avenue / Nugent Avenue to NW 11th Avenue may be closed Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. for the installation of traffic signal foundations on Broward Boulevard. Crews will only work at one cross street at a time.

Description: Project improvements include replacing the bridge over the North Fork of the New River, removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway, upgrading crosswalk ramps to meet ADA requirements, upgrading signs and pavement markings, relocating bus shelters, adding roadway lighting, installing drainage structures, upgrading signalized intersections to mast arms, reconstructing sidewalks, and widening roadway to add bike lanes in each direction. 9. Hillsboro Boulevard Improvements Project from Military Trail to US 1 in Deerfield Beach

Traffic Impact:

• One lane in each direction of Hillsboro Boulevard from Military Trail to US 1 will be closed daily between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. through April 3 for sidewalk, drainage and signal

- improvements and sign installation.
- The outside lane of eastbound Hillsboro Boulevard from Military Trail to I-95 will be closed through early April for widening, sidewalk, drainage and signal improvements.
- The outside lane of eastbound Hillsboro Boulevard from I-95 to SW 3rd Avenue / Martin Luther King Jr. Avenue may be closed continuously for approximately three days Monday through Friday for drainage improvements.

Description: Project improvements include improving the off-ramp from northbound I-95 to eastbound Hillsboro Boulevard including adding a new signalized intersection and adding second lane to increase capacity; relocating and upgrading drainage structures; upgrading crosswalk ramps to meet ADA requirements; constructing new stamped asphalt crosswalks from east of Natura Boulevard to US 1; upgrading existing pedestrian signals to countdown timers; upgrading signalized intersections to mast arms; installing new decorative lighting; constructing new medians east of SE 2 Avenue; and removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway. In addition, signs and pavement markings will be upgraded to reflect the new roadway configuration: from Military Trail to Dixie Highway, there will be three 11-foot travel lanes in each direction; from NE / SE 2 Avenue to US 1, there will be two 11-foot lanes in each direction. Also, bike lanes or sharrows (symbols to designate the outside travel lane will be shared by vehicles and bicycles) will be added as follows: from Military Trail to NW/SW 2 Terrace, there will be a 4-foot-wide bike lane; from NW / SW 2 Terrace to NE / SE 2 Avenue, sharrows in the outside travel lane will designate a shared lane; from NE / SE 2 Avenue to US 1, there will be a 7-foot-wide bike lane. 10. <u>Powerline Road Improvements Project from Sunrise Boulevard to NW 29 Street in Fort Lauderdale and Wilton Manors</u>

Traffic Impact:

- One lane in each direction of Powerline Road from Sunrise Boulevard to NW 29 Street will be closed Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. for sidewalk and curb ramp improvements.
- A sidewalk will be maintained on at least one side of the road within the project limits. Signage will be in place to guide pedestrians through the work zone.
