**O**n Thursday, Jan. 11, 2018, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host an informational Open House for the State Road 80 resurfacing project, from County Road 880 in western Palm Beach County to approximately four miles east of Belle Glade at the US Sugar Railroad Crossing, **4 p.m. until 6 p.m.** at DBI Services, 2728 FL-15, Belle Glade, FL, 33430.

Project personnel will be on hand to discuss the scope of work, schedule, related lane closures, and address questions and comments one-on-one. **Please note: There will not be a formal presentation; guests may arrive any time from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m.**

This 14.8-mile resurfacing and improvements project will begin Monday, Jan. 8, 2018 and is expected to be completed fall 2018, weather permitting. The project cost is \$14.8 million. Work is being performed by Ranger Construction Industries, Inc., with The Corradino Group providing project oversight.

**Scope of Work:**

- **Mill and resurface the roadway**
- **Install rumble strips, thermoplastic pavement markings, and signage**

**Maintenance of Traffic:**

In order to do this work safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes at various times and locations. Work will be done in phases to minimize impacts on the community and motoring public. Project-related lane closures can be expected daily and nightly, as needed.
