**T**he I-95 southbound entrance ramp from Linton Boulevard will undergo a full closure, nightly, as needed, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday night through Thursday night, through February, for construction activities. Traffic will be detoured via Congress Avenue, Peninsula Corp. Drive, and I-95 southbound.

This \$69 million, 2.5-mile project began construction on January 13, 2014 and is expected to be completed in early winter 2018, weather permitting. Work is being performed by Astaldi Construction Corp., with Creative Engineering Group, Inc. administering the construction contract for the Florida Department of Transportation.

### Maintenance of Traffic
