Clint Moore Road Sidewalk Improvements Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Four, is pleased to provide information for the sidewalk installation project on Clint Moore Road from the El Rio Trail to NW 2nd Avenue in the City of Boca Raton. The purpose of the project is to install an 8-foot-wide paved asphalt sidewalk and additional safety enhancements—including pedestrian detectors, signals and an aluminum picket fence on the south side of Clint Moore Road, from the El Rio Trail to NW 2nd Avenue in the City of Boca Raton. Sidewalk project limits do not include the bridge over I-95 which will be replaced under the 95 Express Phase 3B-2 contract. Reconstruction work on the Clint Moore Road bridge over I-95 is currently anticipated to begin in mid to late-2020. The sidewalk improvements project is expected to begin in mid-February 2020.

Construction Cost: \$291,936 Construction Start: Mid-February 2020 Anticipated Completion: Summer 2020

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Work includes installing a new 8-foot wide asphalt sidewalk on the south side of Clint Moore Road from the El Rio Trail to NW 2nd Avenue
- Installation of pedestrian signals and detectors
- Installation of pedestrian aluminum picket railing

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

One eastbound lane will be closed for construction.
Work will typically be performed between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.
