Nightly Intersection Closure at US 1 and Ocean Avenue, Sunday Night March 29, 2020 through Thursday night April 2, 2020

- The intersection of US 1 and Ocean Avenue will be closed, nightly, 10 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday night, March 29, 2020 through Thursday night, April 2, 2020 for asphalt replacement, weather permitting
- Various lanes will be closed in each direction; however, one northbound and southbound lane will be open to local traffic each night
- Detour: Motorists may detour via Seacrest Boulevard, Woolbright Road, and State Road A1A/Ocean Drive during this time
- When intersection closures are not in place, one lane may be closed in each direction, daily, 8 a.m. until 3 p.m., and nightly, 10 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday night through Thursday night
- Advanced notice: Once the work is completed at US 1 and Ocean Avenue, the intersection of US 1 and Boynton Beach Boulevard is expected to be closed the following week, Sunday night, April 5, 2020 through Thursday night, April 9, 2020, weather permitting

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing, roadway reconstruction, concrete curb and gutter, driveway, sidewalk, bridge railing, patterned pavement and bike lane installation
- Drainage, signage and pavement marking upgrades
- Signalization improvements including video and pedestrian detection systems


