Please be advised that milling & paving activities will occur on Spanish River Boulevard, between NE 6th Way and FAU Boulevard, 9 p.m. until 7 a.m., Sunday night through Thursday night, through April, weather permitting.



Milling consists of removing the surface of the road in preparation for new asphalt. This operation is performed with specialized milling machines, and can generate noise. FDOT will be monitoring decibel levels to ensure that the contractor stays within tolerance. Paving requires the use of a vibratory roller to ensure proper compaction of asphalt; vibration monitors will be in place for the duration of this activity and will be monitored and reviewed by FDOT staff.

This roadway construction operation is part of the \$69 million, 2.5-mile interchange project which began construction on January 13, 2014 and is expected to be completed in spring 2018, weather permitting. Work is being performed by Astaldi Construction Corp., with Creative Engineering Group, Inc. administering the construction contract for the Florida Department of Transportation.
