State Road (SR) 80/Southern Boulevard at Forest Hill Boulevard Intersection Improvements Project

SR 80/SOUTHERN BOULEVARD AT FOREST HILL BOULEVARD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

This 0.46-mile intersection improvement project, located in Royal Palm Beach and Wellington, consists of adding a third westbound to southbound left-turn lane from SR 80 to Forest Hill Boulevard, widening the bridge over the C-51 Canal, converting the Forest Hill Boulevard northbound right-turn lanes to a free-flowing right-turn lane, and widening Southern Boulevard to accommodate an eastbound acceleration lane. Other improvements include milling and resurfacing, drainage, curb and gutter, lighting, guardrails, signalization, sidewalks, landscaping, signage and pavement markings.

PROJECT ACTIVITIES

Please see below anticipated work (weather permitting) through April:

- Bridge widening activities on the east and west side of Forest Hill Boulevard
- Construction of shoulder wall (separates sidewalk and canal bank) along eastbound Southern Boulevard
- Activities related to installing traffic signals along southbound Forest Hill Boulevard

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Lane closures may occur 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. on eastbound Southern Boulevard Sunday through Thursday.
- The eastbound right-turn lane from Southern Boulevard to southbound Forest Hill Boulevard may be closed from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.
- Sidewalks are closed on eastbound Southern Boulevard and northbound Forest Hill Boulevard. Pedestrians should follow detours.

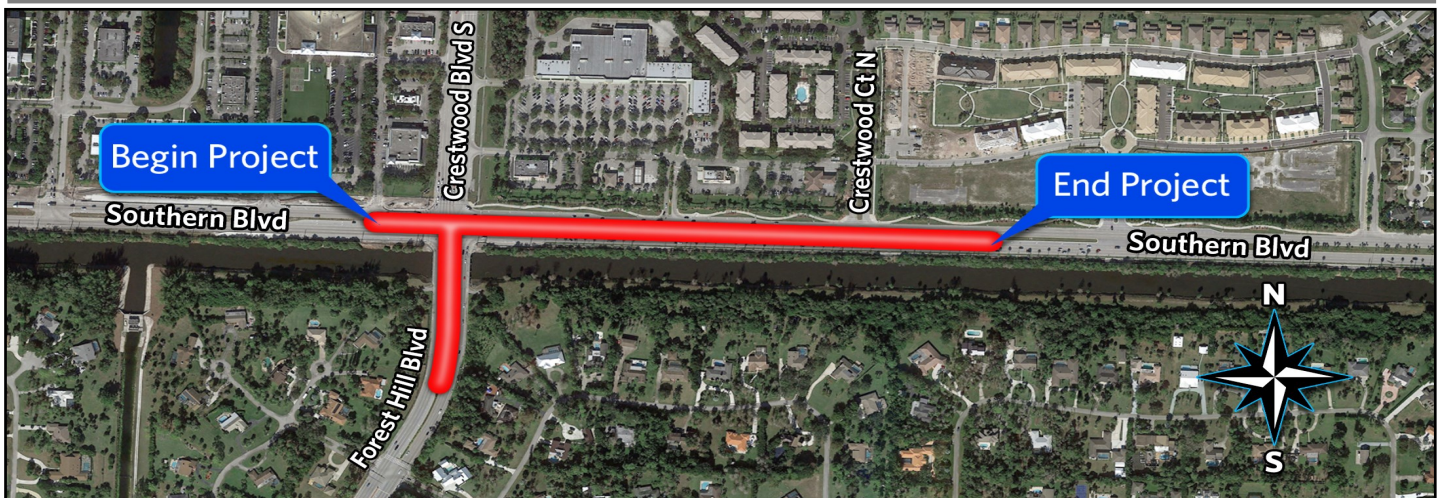
