The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from Spanish River Boulevard will undergo a full closure, nightly, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday night through Thursday night, through April, for construction activities. Traffic will be detoured via Broken Sound Boulevard, Technology Way, and the I-95 southbound entrance ramp from eastbound Yamato Road.

This \$69 million, 2.5-mile project began construction on January 13, 2014 and is expected to be completed in early winter 2018, weather permitting. Work is being performed by Astaldi Construction Corp., with Creative Engineering Group, Inc. administering the construction contract for the Florida Department of Transportation.
