On Tuesday, Apr. 18, 2017, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host an informational Open House for the bridge painting project on Ocean Avenue, over the Intracoastal Waterway between the Town of Ocean Ridge and the City of Boynton Beach, at the Town of Ocean Ridge Commission Chambers and Meeting Room, 6450 N. Ocean Blvd., Ocean Ridge, FL, 33435.

Project personnel will be on hand to discuss the scope of work, painting schedule, related lane closures, and address questions and comments one-on-one. Please note: There will not be a formal presentation. Guests may arrive at any time between 4:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m.

This bridge painting project will begin Monday, Apr. 24, 2017 and is expected to be completed in fall 2017, weather permitting. The painting cost is \$1 million. Work is being performed by Seminole Equipment, Inc., with RS&H, Inc. overseeing the project.

Scope of Work:

- Removal and replacement of structural steel coating system
- Stucco/Class V finish and repairs

Maintenance of Traffic (Proposed daytime Lane Closures):

In order to expedite this work and reduce the contract time by approximately one month, daytime lane closures have been proposed by the contractor. The contractor has requested to work 8 a.m. until 4 p.m., daily, through early fall 2017. Lane closures would take place Monday through Saturday. The contractor would also reserve the right to work Sundays, as needed, but will not be working holidays.

Full night closures with detours (6-10 nights): In order to paint the tips of the bridge, the contractor has been approved to close the bridge for up to 10 nights. The bridge has to remain in an open upright position for this work. A detour route will be in place during this time. This proposed lane closure schedule is currently being reviewed by FDOT, which would reduce the closures to 6 nights, weather permitting. Public feedback is welcome at the Open House regarding the proposed schedule.
