State Road 706/Indiantown Road Intersection Improvements Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will host a Construction Open House for the intersection improvements project on State Road 706/Indiantown Road, from Island Way to State Road 5/US 1, in the Town of Jupiter.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Installation of new light poles at 11 intersections
- Signal upgrades including vehicle detection cameras, microwave detectors, and Bluetooth devices at 14 intersections
- Installation of asphalt pavement, patterned pavement, signage, and pavement markings at 10 intersections

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Up to two (2) lanes may be closed in each direction, nightly,
 9 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday night through Thursday night
- One lane may be closed in each direction, daily, 9 a.m. until 3 p.m., Monday through Friday
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times; pedestrian detours will be in place, as needed
