## Boynton Beach







**From the East:**  
Travel south on Federal Hwy/US-1, west on Woolbright Rd and north on Seacrest Blvd to return to Boynton Beach Blvd.

**From the West:**  
Travel south on Seacrest Blvd, east on Woolbright Rd and north on Federal Hwy/US-1 to return to Boynton Beach Blvd.

**From the I-95 North:**  
Take Exit 56 for Woolbright Rd. Travel east on Woolbright Rd and north on Federal Hwy/US-1 to arrive at Boynton Beach Blvd.

**From the I-95 South:**  
Take Exit 59 for Gateway Blvd. Travel east on Gateway Blvd and south on Federal Hwy/US-1 to arrive at Boynton Beach Blvd.
