Project Location



Project Scope

- Repaving the existing pavement
- Widening shoulders to accommodate 8-foot shoulders (from St. Paul of the Cross Catholic Church to south of Portage Landing North)
- Restriping to provide designated bike lanes
- Reconstructing pedestrian sidewalk curb ramps
- Traffic signal replacement to mast arm system
- Upgrading lighting at signalized intersection
- Upgrading pedestrian signalization at intersection
- Upgrading vehicle detection system
- Upgrading pavement markings and signs

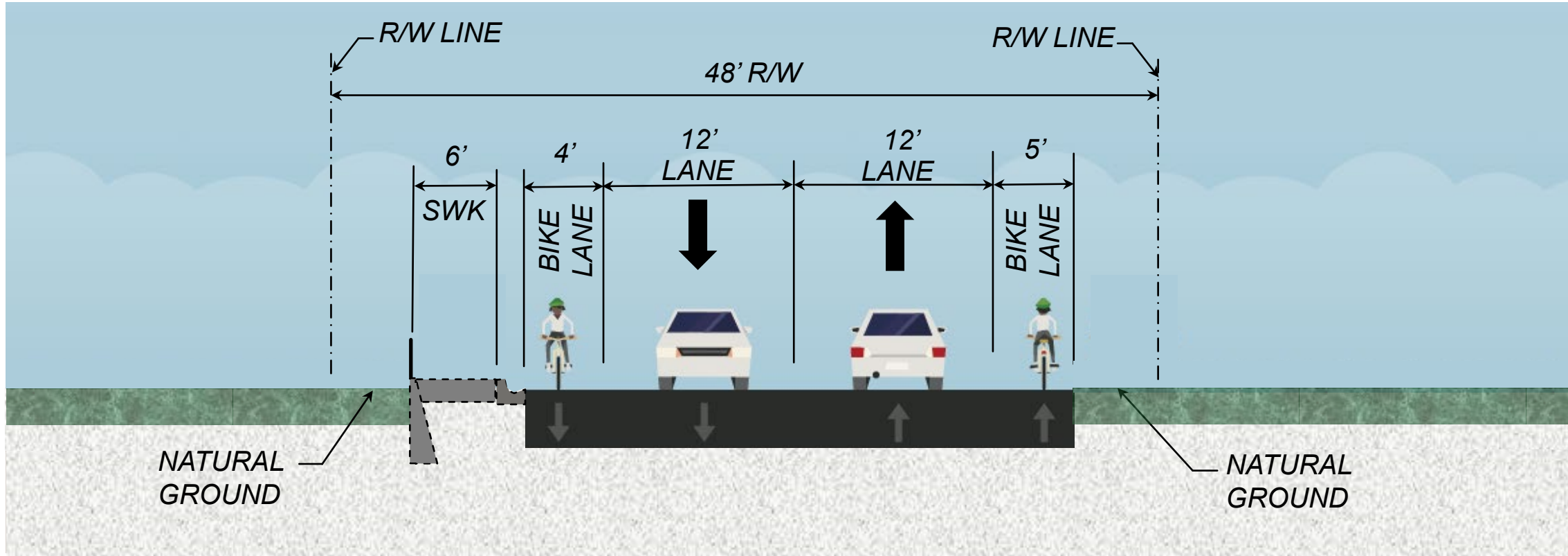


Project Schedule and Cost

- Construction Start: **Spring 2024**
- Construction Completion: **Summer 2025**
- Construction Cost Estimate: **\$2.6 Million**

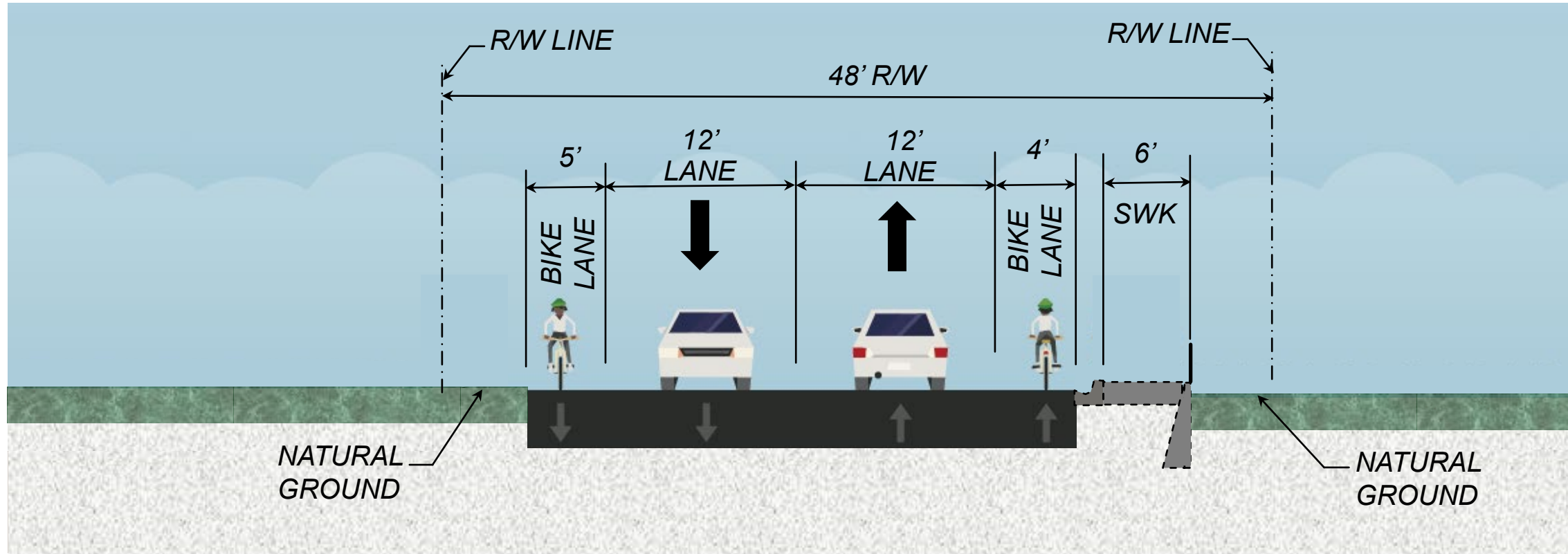

(South of John D. MacArthur Park Entrance)

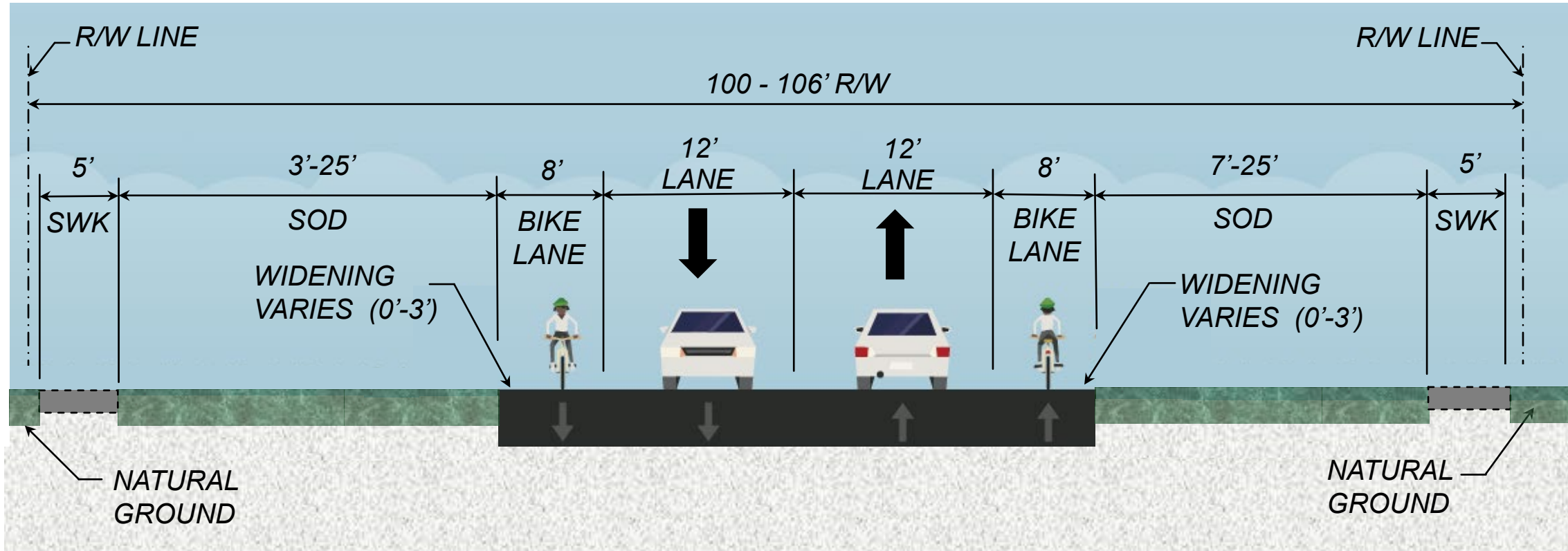

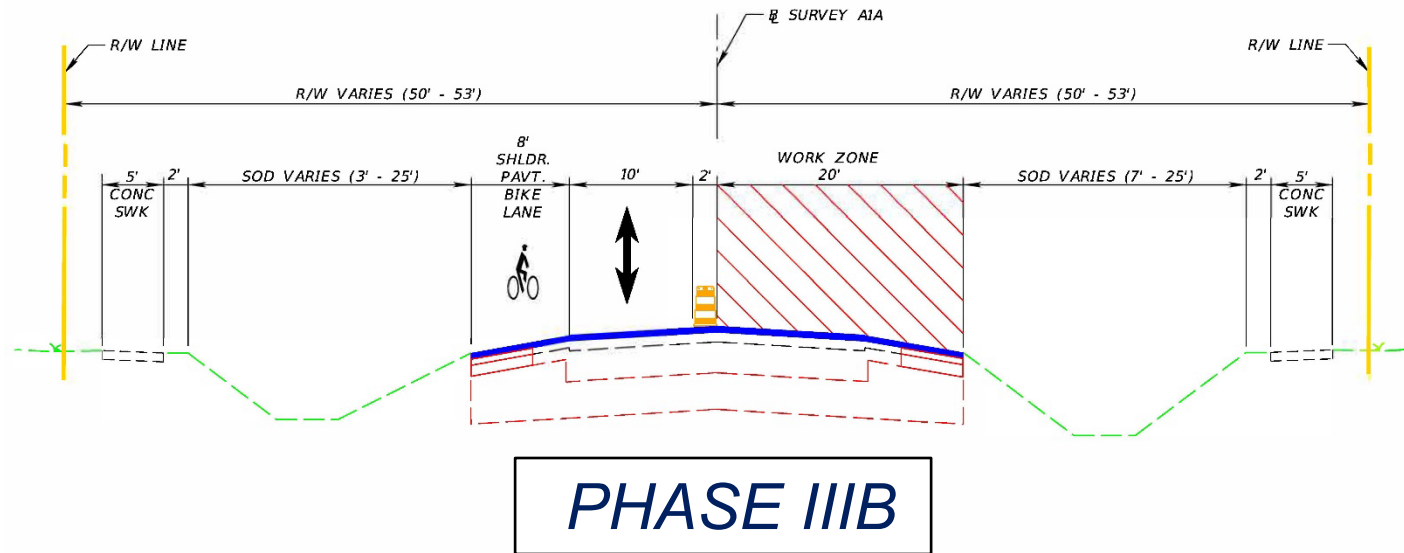
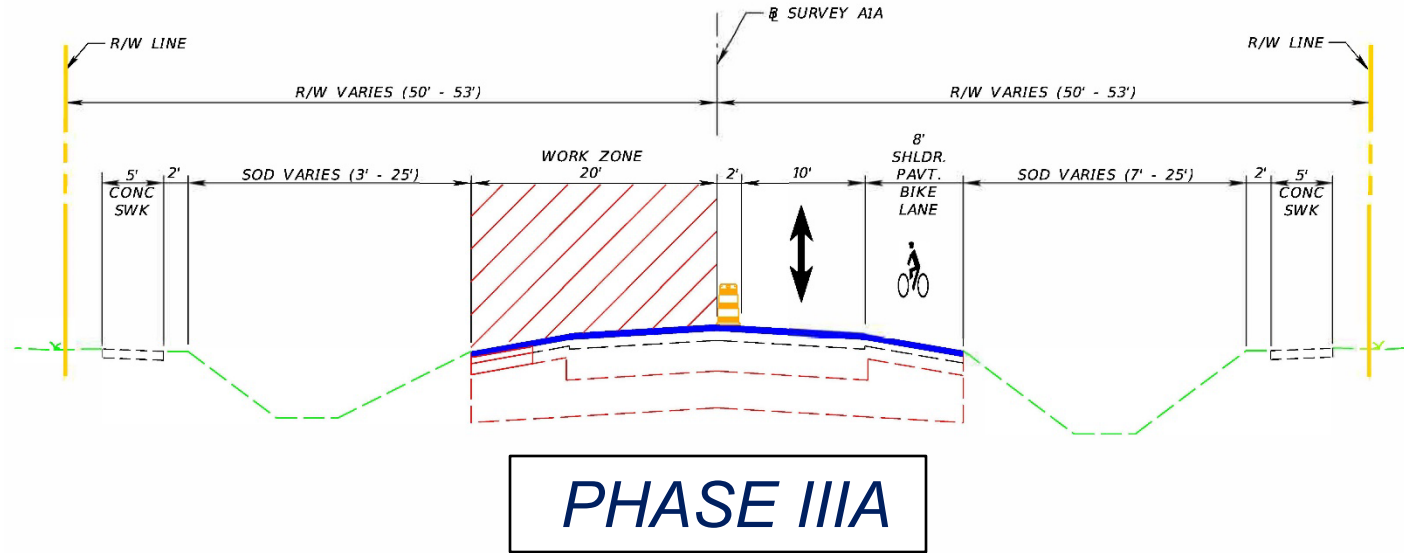
Construction Impacts
