Project personnel will be on hand to discuss the scope of work, schedule, related lane closures, and address questions and comments one-on-one. <u>Please note</u>: There will not be a formal presentation. Guests may arrive at any time between 4 p.m. and 6 p.m.

This 0.7-mile sidewalk project will begin Monday, June 5, 2017 and is expected to be completed late summer 2017, weather permitting. The project cost is \$363,409.09. Work is being performed by Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc., with FDOT overseeing the project.

Scope of Work:

- Sidewalk installation and driveway reconstruction on the south side of the roadway only
- Installation of detectable warning surfaces, signage, pavement marking, and sod
- Drainage improvements
- Utility adjustments

Maintenance of Traffic:

In order to do this work safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes at various times and locations. Work will be done in phases to minimize impacts on the community and motoring public. Project-related lane closures can be expected daily, 7:30 a.m. until 7:30 p.m., Monday through Sunday, as needed.
