SR 7 Resurfacing Improvements Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, is pleased to provide information for the resurfacing improvements project on SR 7 from Atlantic Avenue in the City of Delray Beach to Boynton Beach Boulevard in the City of Boynton Beach.

Construction Cost: \$7,969,825

Construction Start: June 24, 2019

Anticipated Completion: Late Winter 2020

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing with minor shoulder widening
- Drainage improvements and lighting upgrades
- Installation of gravity wall, guardrail, signing and pavement markings
- Intersection signalization improvements at Atlantic Avenue and Boynton Beach Boulevard, including traffic monitoring systems and pedestrian detection/signals

TRAFFIC IMPACTS


- One lane may be closed in each direction, daily, 9 a.m. until 4 p.m., Monday through Friday
- One lane may be closed in each direction, nightly, 7 p.m. until 7 a.m., Sunday night through Friday
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times
