SR 5/US 1 Improvements Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will host a Construction Open House for the SR 5/US 1 (South Federal Highway) improvements project from George Bush Boulevard in the City of Delray Beach to Murano Bay Drive in the City of Boynton Beach.

Construction Cost: \$5,430,718

Construction Start: Early July 2019

Anticipated Completion: Summer 2020

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing, roadway reconstruction, concrete curb and gutter, driveway, sidewalk, bridge railing and bike lane installation
- Drainage, signage, and pavement marking upgrades
- Signalization improvements including vehicle and pedestrian detection systems

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- One lane may be closed in each direction, daily, 10 a.m. until 3 p.m., Monday through Friday
- One lane may be closed in each direction, nightly, 10 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday night through Thursday morning
- Full closures at intersections will be needed for roadway reconstruction; advanced notice will be provided prior to any closures
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times
