The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Four, will host a Construction Open House for the SR 5/US 1 (South Federal Highway) improvements project from Hypoluxo Road to Waterway Drive in the Town of Lantana.

Construction Cost: \$1,965,070

Construction Start: June 10, 2019

Anticipated Completion: Spring 2020

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing with minor widening, concrete curb and gutter, driveway, and sidewalk installation
- Drainage, irrigation, signage and pavement marking upgrades
- Signalization improvements including vehicle and pedestrian detection systems

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Daytime lane closure restrictions for sidewalk work, Monday through Sunday:
 - Southbound lane closures are not permitted 1 p.m. - 7 p.m.
 - Northbound lane closures are permitted at any time
- Nighttime lane closure restrictions for road work, Monday through Sunday:
 - Lane closures are permitted in each direction, 8 p.m. - 7 a.m.

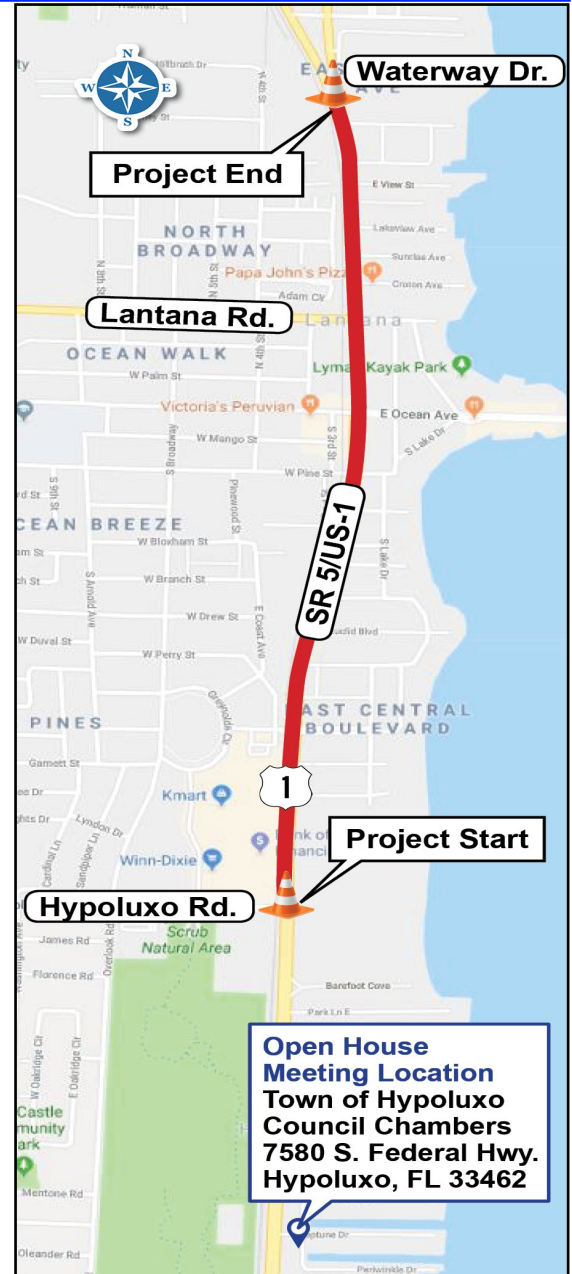
